## Agenda Items

- 1. Financials there is approximately \$48,000 in the accounts (PAC to look at most recent bank statements to determine the exact amount).
  - a. How are we able to use funds from the gaming account; what expenses can be applied to the gaming account? **PAC** to look into the particulars.
- 2. Fundraising options for this school year:
  - a. Fundraising drive requesting (cheque) donations from parents <u>Heather</u> will confirm who the cheques are to be made payable to & will also check with the District to determine if parents can donate online (via the same platform that collects payments for planners, school tshirts, etc.). <u>PAC</u> to work on this letter.
  - Book fair is an option; Mrs. Sturn is willing to organize this event (November and/or May. Yojana will discuss the details with Mrs. Sturn.
  - c. Family Photo night <u>PAC</u> to contact HT Photography to set this up.
  - d. Christmas gift baskets there will be some changes to what was done in the past.
    - i. The baskets may be tailored towards the kids rather than adults; ie. PAC will purchase items to be put into each basket and then will be raffled.
    - ii. If baskets are created as in past years, donated items brought in by students will be left for a "quarantine period" before being put into gift baskets.
    - iii. This event may be moved from Christmas to Chinese New Year if we are in a better situation.
  - e. Hot lunches if we are able to find local businesses that are able to pack individual hot lunches per division, this may be an option.
    - i. Can we use the School's online payment platform for hot lunches rather than Munchalunch.com? *Heather* will look into this.
- 3. Teacher Wishlist <u>Heather</u> will forward an updated list for this school year to the PAC for review.
  - a. Virtual Hip Hop was a success last year so it has been booked for this upcoming spring.
  - b. School laptops will need to be replaced in the next few years.

## Principal's Update

- 1. A Teacher appreciation lunch was done on the first day of school this year; this was in lieu of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Teacher appreciation lunch in the spring of last year due to the updated restrictions put in place.
- 2. There are 18 divisions/400 students this year. The number of students has gone down as there are less kindergarten students entering school than Grade 7s moving onto high school.
- 3. The 2021 school year has started on a smooth note!
