## Treasury Report ~ Laura C.

- We are in a healthy financial position; could allocate another $\$ 20 \mathrm{k}$ to the playground (for a total of $\$ 45 \mathrm{k}$ ) and we'd still have a reserve of nearly $\$ 2 k$, plus a set-aside for next year's budget of $\$ 31 \mathrm{k}$. If we make more than $\$ 5 \mathrm{k}$ at the Spring Fling, and/or more than $\$ 5 \mathrm{k}$ in HL Round 3 (we seem to be tracking $\sim \$ 6 \mathrm{k} /$ round), we could probably even commit as much as an additional $\$ 25 k$ to the playground fund, which would bring us up to an even $\$ 50 k$ to start off next year.
- still waiting to hear about possible playground funding from provincial government.
- GAMES: Laura, Jennifer, Gurpreet; games are pretty much ready to go; still need the instruction sheets made up and laminated for the 2 new games
- Surf's Up is out; Pizza Toss refurbished; two new games added "Tic Tac Toe" and "Hoppin' Horse Races"
- Slap Shot radar game might not be available this year; need to find out about Goofy Goggle Golfing
