- □ BC's government website on the new curriculum, reporting and other issues: <a href="https://curriculum.gov.bc.ca/">https://curriculum.gov.bc.ca/</a>
- □ The Ministry of Education is seeking feedback from parents on how student progress is communicated. The province has re-vamped the curriculum for Kindergarten through Grade 9 and is now looking to develop a new approach to reporting student learning. In Surrey, depending on the school and the teacher, progress is currently relayed in several ways, including traditional report cards, student digital portfolios and parent-teacher meetings. In a letter to parents, Education Minister Mike Bernier says the goal is "to develop a student reporting process that gives families a deeper understanding of their child's progress at school through timely and comprehensive information."
  - ✓ Until February 28, 2017, input from parents can be shared at <a href="http://engage.gov.bc.ca/yourkidsprogress">http://engage.gov.bc.ca/yourkidsprogress</a>/.
  - ✓ The province will gather the feedback and unveil a reporting plan in June 2017.

#### Hot Lunch Coordinator (for next school year, 2017-2018)

- Oversee Hot Lunch (HL) program and coordinate set-up on HL website.
- Source vendors, negotiate & set prices, place weekly HL orders, purchase supplies as needed.
- Determine dates for HL & pre-selling ordering periods.
- Find HL Leaders & communicate with them regularly, and oversee volunteers.
- Create price lists & instructions for HL Leaders, volunteers, staff, & parents.
- Communicate with school staff, parents, PAC, & PAC Treasurer, and create emails, notices & signs.
- Write cheques to vendors, post payments, & prep for deposit; reconcile invoices to website.

#### Hot Lunch Volunteer Coordinator (for next school year, 2017-2018)

- Create sign-up sheets, monitor & ensure we have enough volunteers in each classroom every week.
- Send emails to coordinate volunteers, and fill in on HL days when necessary.
