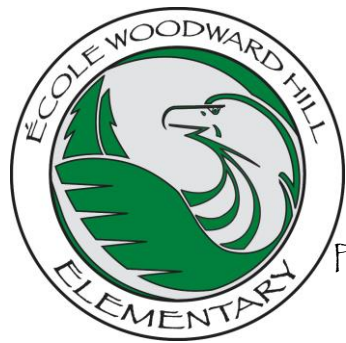

#### **1. Call to order:**

- Cindy introduced herself and acknowledged that we are standing on the unceded territory, a stolen traditional land.
- Called to order at 6:33 pm.

#### **2. Adoption of Agenda:**

- Motion to adopt – Bernadette
- Seconded – Andrea

#### **3. Adoption of Minutes from AGM 2020:**

- This is only for those individuals who attended the AGM to discuss the roles and responsibilities.
  - Motion to accept – Manpreet
  - Seconded – Steve
- Cindy will distribute the AGM minutes to everyone

#### **4. Budget – Treasurer and President:**

- Cindy discussed the budget
- Not all money was used last year due to COVID
- We had \$11,000 left to carry into this year, leaving us in good shape
- We received Gaming Grant of \$14,200 (\$20/student – 725 students) to be used in the next 3 years

#### **5. President's Report:**

- This year PAC will look different due to COVID-19
- How we will do fundraising
- Think creative ways to keep the community together (blended classes)

#### **6. Principal's Report:**

- We will try to combine the newsletter to go out after the PAC meeting
- Halloween
  - PAC has nicely coordinated to have a pumpkin patch at the school
  - They were able to purchase them for \$1.00 each
  - Requested volunteers to meet on Thursday, 29<sup>th</sup> at 6:45 am at school to help put out all the pumpkins on the field
- Grade 7 leadership team along with blended class to have them monitor younger children during lunch time. This will be done from the hallway
- Haunted House
  - School have decided to decorate one room as the Haunted House
  - Brad reached out Potter's and they have given some lighting fixtures
  - This will be held on Friday, 30<sup>th</sup> for everyone to join along with blended classes
- We have received a lot of perishable donations, thank you to everyone.
- We welcome everyone to wear their Halloween costumes on Friday, 30<sup>th</sup>
  - No scary mask
  - No weapon
- Remembrance
  - We will have a slideshow of family members, an image of a person or groups
  - Please indicate of where they served and their role to Woodward Hill email
- Allergies
  - Spoke to staff about allergy at school
  - Have a term known as "allergy awareness"
  - Awareness/Avoid/Action

- We will have nurse come to the school to show us how an EpiPen is to be applied
- Weather
  - Is getting very wet and appreciate all parents who are sending their kids dressed appropriately for the weather
- Staffing
  - 2 new staff will be joining
- Brad mentioned that he will need to leave by 7 pm as he has another meeting to attend
- Cindy opened to everyone for any questions to Brad
  - Steve had question about the pickup/drop off zone on how to educate the new families who are now attending the school
  - Brad mentioned that yes, it is something for us to remind new families about the procedure. He noticed that some parents are parking and leaving their car to drop off their children. This is only pickup and drop off zone.
  - Brad is speaking to those parents or leaving a note on their windshield
  - RCMP has been around in the morning to watch the traffic. Cindy mentioned to have a parent to do the sidewalk on 142<sup>nd</sup> Street instead of a staff.
  - Brad mentioned to everyone if you see anyone who is speeding to write down their license plate number and report it to the Police
  - Crosswalk that Cindy patrols are having a lot of traffic jams when kids are crossing. Suggestion to have a flashing light or have a Bylaw Enforcement to come by during those busy times and hand out tickets to those individuals who are parked in front of the fire hydrant or crosswalk.
  - Speed bumps was another option

Action: Monica will contact City of Surrey requesting for guidance on what we can do to protect the community. Speed bumps, flashing light.

### **7. Baking with Bernie:**

- On November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- To all Woodward Hill children and their families
- Bernie will be baking in her kitchen via zoom
- She will bake Chocolate Sugar Cookie with henna design on them

**9. Purdy's and Poinsettias (off-side fundraiser):**

- We cannot do anything at the school due to COVID
- This will be done off-site from the school. Monica volunteered her home (which is located next door to the school) for people to pick-up their items
- Carly takes the lead on Purdy's order and she will contact them and have the information out soon

**10. Vendor Online:**

- Angela spoke about this as she had done craft fairs for the last 2 years at school but this year due to COVID it will be online
- It's a great fundraising for the school
- It will be online by engaging with the vendors to support them and for certain proceeds being donated to the school. An online party
- We will advertise 1 or 2 vendors per week
- Please contact Angela if you know any vendors who are interested to join
- Suggestion to have a page on the website outline our ongoing fundraising through COBBS, Big Ridge

**11. Grade 7 Committee:**

- Brad mentioned that we will discuss this in January
- COVID friendly for Grade 7's
- Several ideas came out; Goodie bags (Grammy's) and hand them out to the children

**12. Additional Questions/Comments:**

- We had a request from a teacher to supply hand sanitizers to the classroom as they didn't receive it from the district
- There were discussions and Cindy will speak to Brad and update us all
