Dear Parents,

The PAC is in the process of updating and improving our Earthquake Bin to ensure we are properly prepared in the event of an extended stay at school during an emergency. As part of this preparedness, we would like each student to have a 72 hour comfort pack which includes: 6 packages of emergency drinking water, a thermal emergency blanket, food ration for 72 hours, a whistle with lanyard, and a 12 hour emergency light stick. These comfort packs are available for purchase through Edu-Pac for a cost of \$14.99 + Tax = \$15.74. These comfort packs are good for 5 years and students leaving the school before their expiry are welcome to take their packs with them to their new school. We would like to order these comfort packs by the end of November. Please submit your order form with a cheque made out to Ray Shepherd PAC by November 28, 2014.
