

Playground Update

Our Playground Replacement Committee is hard at work researching designs & ideas for our upcoming playground replacement

project. We'll be working with *Habitat Systems* to design & install our new playground starting in 2019 (http://www.habitat-systems.com). Preliminary ideas will be presented at a special Playground meeting in November; details TBA, meeting will be open to all.

The south portion of the primary playground (pink/yellow with ramps) is slated for mandatory removal in the 2019/20 school year, while we've been advised by the District that the north intermediate playground is scheduled for removal in the year or two after.

PAC has decided to fundraise for **both playground replacement projects** at once, as we don't want "fundraising fatigue" to set in with two back-to-back campaigns. The goal is to work with *Habitat* to design both replacements at once, and fundraise accordingly.

Peace Arch's Emergency Preparedness supplies are being re-provisioned this year.

DID YOU KNOW?... PAC buys and replenishes Emergency Preparedness supplies that are stored in a secure metal bin in the school parking lot. There are sufficient supplies for all

students and staff for a 72-hour period and include things like: high calorie emergency food rations, a water purification system, first aid supplies, shelter supplies, hand tools, personal protective equipment, a portable radio, flashlights, and everything else we could possibly need in the case of a significant natural disaster. In 2013 all classrooms were outfitted with emergency/survival kits, and this year we have purchased 3 additional kits for our three new divisions. Many thanks to Peace Arch parent **Arin B.** for taking on this important project over the past several years!
