Admin Report ~ Fiona E.

- the school is settling in post-Oliver! From Erin H.: sincere thank you to all the parents who worked so tirelessly for the amazing production of Oliver! The parent group at the school is so enthused to do another musical production ASAP, perhaps in two years.
- successful Remembrance Day ceremony last week; beautiful performance by choir; excellent audience skills demonstrated by all students, including younger grades (bravo!).
- staff is fully engaged in helping to design the new Learning Commons space.
- discussion about how we communicate at the school; admin would like to know what works and what doesn't.
 - core is the child's agenda; next is the school website: (<u>https://www.surreyschools.ca/schools/peacea/</u>)
 - school Twitter account (@PeaceArchElem) and "SchoolLink" app
 - \circ $$ teachers' emails will hopefully be updated to school website
- 3 new filtered water fillers: gym entrance, 300-pod, 400-pod; students can use to fill their own bottles.
- the school's **Technology Plan**, including the Goals and Vision over the next three years:
 - to outfit each classroom to be projection- and technology-ready, including for example document cameras, Apple TVs, iPads or iPad minis, laptops, etc.
 - to support student learning with 21st century tools, in both classrooms and the Learning Commons.
 - o to ensure all classrooms/students have technology tools for Communicating Student Learning.
 - our school's technology plan is looked at and revised as needed every year as technology evolves and our school community's needs evolve.
- 3-Year Plan for 30 additional student laptops, 30 ipad minis and cart, and 20 items to replace older tech.
- the Surrey School District has improved WiFi in Surrey elementary schools.

Treasurer's Report ~ Laura C.

- PAC bank documents circulated; PAC is in healthy financial shape, without any savings for eventual playground replacement.
- final Oliver numbers (still waiting for DVD sales to conclude): approx. \$3,500 final cost to PAC for Oliver.
- Cheque-Writing Campaign is woefully short if we're hoping to start raising funds this year for playground replacement; we've had donations from only 13% of families at the school.

DPAC (District Parent Advisory Council) ~ Rowland W.

- last DPAC meeting was Oct 26th; focused on advocacy for funding for education.
- DPAC continues to meet with MLAs, and advocate against the provincial budget as the next provincial election approaches.
- PAC 101, educating PACs on how to run meetings, financial checks and balances, etc.
- 'Societies Act' coming into effect this year; we have 2 years to transition (http://www2.gov.bc.ca/societies act transition guide.pdf)
- next meeting Wed., Nov. 23 at the District Education Centre (14033 92nd Ave. Rm 2020) 7:00-9:00pm: curriculum reporting options & guidelines; FreshGrade; Ministry of Education is seeking feedback from parents re. new curriculum reporting system.
- plans for new Grandview Heights secondary school: not until year 3 of the current capital plan (2015-2018), i.e. work won't begin on new high school for at least 2 years.
