Principal's Report

- We have had a busy start to the year. Covid-19 has definitely presented its challenges
 to our school opening. Currently we have 329 students registered in our face to face
 program and 94 students in our blended program. We have 7 students attending a
 regional blended model meaning they are registered at Cindrich but are being taught by
 a teacher from another school. There is currently no room in our blended program.
- Classes are paired into learning groups/cohorts. This mainly plays a role when playing outside as classes are paired together in a play zone. This took a lot of learning but students are now doing a great job!
- We have had 2 emergency drills: fire and earthquake. We will be having a lockdown drill in November.
- Our annual Cindrich Pumpkin Patch will take place on October 28th. We are asking for a 2 dollar donation per student. This helps to alleviate the cost of the pumpkins as the are quite high this year. It is a tradition we wanted to maintain for normalcy of the school.
- As of right now, no school sports are permitted. However, we are trying to organize sports within our grade 6/7 cohorts to give our older students a chance to participate in physical activity.
- For assemblies, we have been doing virtual assemblies where students have created videos that is shared within the school. This has been a nice way to connect with the school. We will do something similar for Remembrance day.

Financial Report

- Our beginning budget for the year is approximately \$13000.00
- This will be a hard year in regards to increasing this total. Half come from gaming supplies.

New Business

Fundraising Ideas: Face Masks with school Logo- Patty will inquire with Wally and Carolina will inquire with an independent provider to compare costs

-Patty will inquire with other schools about their fundraising ideas

Classroom funds: In previous years, teachers have been given a certain amount of money from the PAC to spend on their classroom. Will this continue this year? What amount would you be willing to provide?

-Unanimous vote agreed to \$100 per class to support student learning

PE Equipment:

Our current PE equipment is old and outdated. We are missing class sets of useful equipment. We would like to propose asking for approximately \$3000.00 from PAC funds to purchase equipment for this year.
