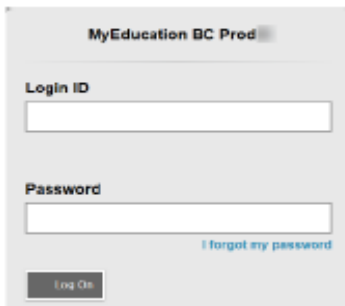

Logging In

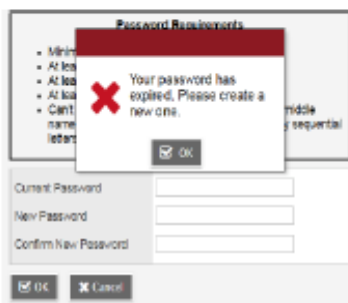
A Login ID and a temporary Password will be provided to you by email at the time your account is created. The email will come from 'sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca'.

1. Log in from a desktop computer only.
2. Enter your **Login ID** and temporary **Password**
3. Click **Log On**



4. You will be prompted to change your password. '**Current Password**' is the temporary password you were provided. Enter a '**New Password**' and '**Confirm New Password**' using the criteria outlined in the password requirements.

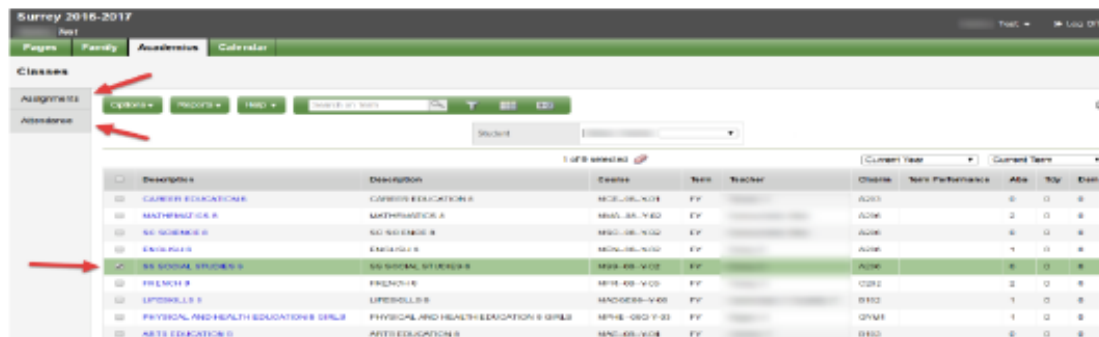

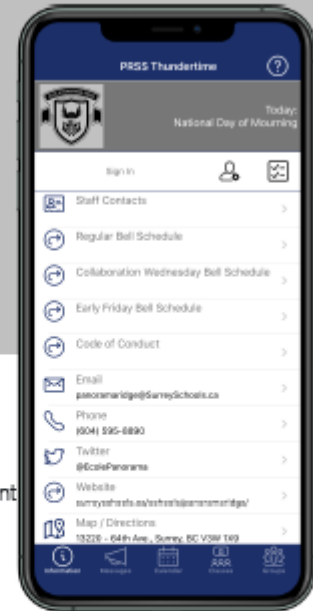

The site will open and available for students to select their locker, based on the following schedule:

To log in, you will need to enter your user name, which will be your **STUDENT #** (which can be found on your go-card, course schedule or report card), and then your password (which is your **BIRTHDAY**. The format of the password is YYYYMMDD, so for example. if you were born October 6, 2010, your password would be 20101006).

If you are new to Panorama Ridge or are having trouble logging into the system, it may be because your log-in information has not been entered into the system yet, or the **STUDENT # / BIRTHDAY** may not be correct.
