Dear parent/guardian,

As we start our final two weeks of this school year, I'd like to take this opportunity to thank each of you for your continued vigilance in following our health and safety protocols. Thanks to the hard work of our staff, students, and families, we were able to safely keep our students in school for the full year.

You may have heard recently that the Provincial Health Officer (PHO) announced step 2 of <u>B.C.'s Restart Plan</u>, which outlines phases for a careful, four-step plan to gradually begin to restart our important social connections, businesses and activities.
