## EAST KENSINGTON OUTDOOR LEARNING



Join a growing worldwide movement of learning in nature at East Kensington's Outdoor Learning (EKOLogy). EKOLogy is Surrey's only outdoor learning program. Students engage in outdoor experiences that integrate BC's curriculum with children's innate curiosity through emergent, inquiry-based, and place-based learning.
