## **Immunizations for Grades 6-9**

Please see the attached letter from Fraser Health regarding the continuation of the Immunization Program for schoolaged children.

The letter is a notification that Fraser Health's Immunization Program for school-aged children will resume this year beginning with students in grades 7 and 10 who missed their immunizations during the 2019-2020 school year due to COVID-19. These appointments will be located at local public health units. Health unit staff will contact families to book these immunization appointments over the spring and summer. The immunization programs for kindergarten, Grade 6 and 9 students from the 2020-2021 school year are currently under development.

#### **Outdoor Equipment**

Thank you so much to our PAC for the outdoor sports equipment. Each class received a collection of balls and various other pieces of equipment to use during our recess and lunch time breaks. This allows for students to have some games to play during those unstructured times. Our staff then decided to purchase some laundry baskets to store the equipment in. Our thoughts around this was so the equipment could dry out and also the holes on the sides of the baskets would allow the fogging equipment to sanitize more surface areas of the balls. This would, in theory, allow the equipment to last longer. Thank you PAC for this gift of play!

## Planning for the 2021/2022 School Year
