Background

School District No. 36 (Surrey) authorizes the use of privately owned personal computers and devices within the school as a tool to support learning in the classroom.

Computer/Device owners agree to:

- Adhere fully to the SD36 Acceptable Use Policy (see over) and that computer/device and network usage will also be governed by school and classroom rules and expectations
- Strictly ensure that software installed on their privately owned computer/device are licensed for their use
- Give their computer/device an appropriate machine name

SD36 and schools are **NOT** responsible for:

- Repair of privately owned computers/electronic devices (hardware or software)
- Compatibility problems with its networks, computers, and software
- Network connectivity problems
- Theft of or damage to privately owned computers/devices, software, or data
- Providing licenses for software used on privately owned computers/devices

Procedures

- Students connect to the SD36 Guest network
- Schools communicate procedures around in class and break time use of devices
- Students conduct themselves in a responsible, ethical, and polite manner in accordance with the District's code of conduct with their devices.
- Students using personal devices would be expected to act in the same manner as when using district devices
