


Philosophy 12


Question: What are the ways we see the world through and how do we make sense (self?) through/with these ways of seeing?




Each week we will start by asking + responding to some of the big philosophical questions + focus on the relevance of these questions + ideas.

The Questions will be grouped and sequenced with respect to the branches of philosophy.




These branches differentiate, but also impact each other — swirling together in our experience.

Each Assignment is the opportunity to develop an aspect of a curricular dr/+ core competency.	Each competency can be seen as an image	Each competency is made of pieces. (facets)	Each Assignment = Practice; a chance to refine/develop course competencies
Over the year + with development... pieces might fit together
