## **This Week at Fleetwood Park - Principal's Message: January 28th to February 1st**

Good morning and welcome to the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of 2018/19 at Fleetwood Park Secondary!

Monday morning was a bright and energetic start to our new semester. There was a positive and exciting buzz of anticipation across our school as students and staff met to begin a new learning journey. The first day of a new class is a special time for all of us, and the clear skies and sunshine helped add to the energy of the day. I am very pleased to say that all of our classes were in place, our students and staff were ready to go, and there have been minimal timetable adjustments required. The day and semester started very smoothly! This year our enrollment has remained very stable. We have 1525 students registered with us and we do not anticipate any significant changes over the next 5 months. We would like to welcome back to Fleetwood Park Secondary staff members Ms. Stewart, Ms. Smeltzer and Ms. Robertson.

Students, as you start your new courses and set new goals for your future, now is a very appropriate time to reflect on your progress so far this year. Are you involved in school-life and engaged within our community? Do you seek assistance and ask questions whenever you need extra help? Do you give back to our school community through your leadership, volunteerism and citizenship? Do you seek new challenges and push yourself to grow and develop every day? Are you finding a healthy balance between academic study, physical and mental health, work, extracurriculars, friendship and family? Do you take time to recognize and celebrate your successes along your learning journey? Do you recognize and honour all those around you who provide you care and support? Now is an ideal time for all of us to reset, refocus and rededicate ourselves to our own personal life and learning plans. Good luck in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to all Dragons!

Fleetwood Park staff had a very busy day on Monday as we introduced our new courses, met new students and also attended our first staff meeting of the semester. We had the chance to welcome back new staff and review the latest changes to the BC Graduation Program. Provincial assessments have been revised for next year. Next year grade 10 students will write the Graduation Numeracy and Graduation Literacy assessments. In 2020/21, students in grade 12 will write the Graduation Literacy assessment. (Next year will be the final year for the current Language Arts 12 Provincial Exam). Please see the details below.

### ***Provincial Graduation Assessments***

- Three Provincial Graduation Assessments, aligned with the curriculum, in literacy and numeracy are required for graduation.
- The Graduation Numeracy Assessment was implemented in January 2018. The Grade 10 Graduation Literacy Assessment will be introduced in 2019/20 and the Grade 12 Graduation Literacy Assessment will be introduced in 2020/21.
- The following policies are associated with the new assessments:
  - Required for graduation.
  - Stand-alone assessments (not tied to a specific course).
  - Students are expected to take the Graduation Numeracy Assessment in their Grade 10 year.
  - Students are expected to take a Graduation Literacy Assessment in their Grade 10 and in their Grade 12 year.
  - Students must complete each assessment for graduation. There will be an opportunity for students to re-write the assessments to improve their achievement level.
  - Scored on a proficiency scale.
  - The student's best outcome for each of the Provincial Graduation Assessments will be recorded on their final transcript.

- In 2019/20 (Grade 11) – Grade 10 Graduation Numeracy Assessment (if not already written)
- In 2020/21 (Grade 12) – Grade 12 Graduation Literacy Assessment

#### If I'm currently in Grade 11...

- In 2018/19 (Grade 11) – Grade 10 Graduation Numeracy Assessment (if not already written)
- In 2019/20 (Grade 12) – Grade 10 Graduation Numeracy Assessment (if not already written)

#### If I'm currently in Grade 12...

- In 2018/19 (Grade 12) – Language Arts 12 provincial exam
- In 2018/19 (Grade 12) – Grade 10 Graduation Numeracy Assessment (if not already written and if Math 10 provincial exam not written)

This week, I enjoyed observing Ms. Smeltzer's students participate in the "Tarp Grid Challenge." The purpose is to move all players along a designated pathway of squares from one side of the mat to the other in a time limit of thirty minutes. Players rely on non-verbal communication as they attempt to decipher which squares are safe, and which squares are danger. Discussions afterward focus on Team Roles/Talents, and the Stages of Team Development (Forming, Storming, Norming, Performing). The class had a great time!

It is wonderful to see so many students attending the after-school practices, getting fit, developing their rugby skills, and building new friendships. Great thanks to all of our Rugby coaches for your mentorship.



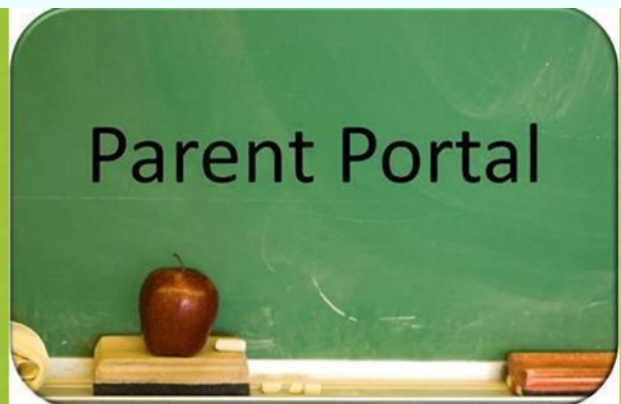


