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

Hello from Fleetwood Park Secondary,

However, despite our grey weather and recent health issue distractions and challenges, our students continue to arrive with smiles and show us their school spirit. It is already Thursday and our students and staff are busy learning together!



It has been another "interesting" week at our school as we have worked closely with the Fraser Health Authority. As you know, as a result of a measles exposure (Oct 30-Nov 2) at the school, Fraser Health has coordinated a Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) vaccination program for students and staff. This has been a very significant process involving our entire community. As each day passes, our efforts required to implement and track the program become more manageable. Next week many of our students/staff remaining at home will be permitted to return to school with the rest returning on November 26th. Again, I would like to thank the entire Fleetwood Park community for your resilience and understanding as the school has responded to this health issue. Your support during this challenging time has been much appreciated.

This week, in addition to the MMR vaccination management, our students and staff continued to shine! On Tuesday, selected grade 11 students had the opportunity to pilot the Ministry's new Literacy Assessment. Next year, the Literacy Assessment will become a graduation requirement for students. It was very helpful for us to see the format and content of the assessment. This will help inform our staff in preparation for next year's implementation. Thank you to Ms. Colombara for your leadership in organizing this opportunity. Wednesday was a great day for all of our Grade 9 students as they participated in "Take Your Kid to Work Day" 2018! Thanks to all parents/guardians/friends and family who sponsored a grade 9 student at your place of employment for the day. I believe this is a very important first glimpse of the world of work for our students... it is a day they will remember, and a highlight of their grade 9 year.
