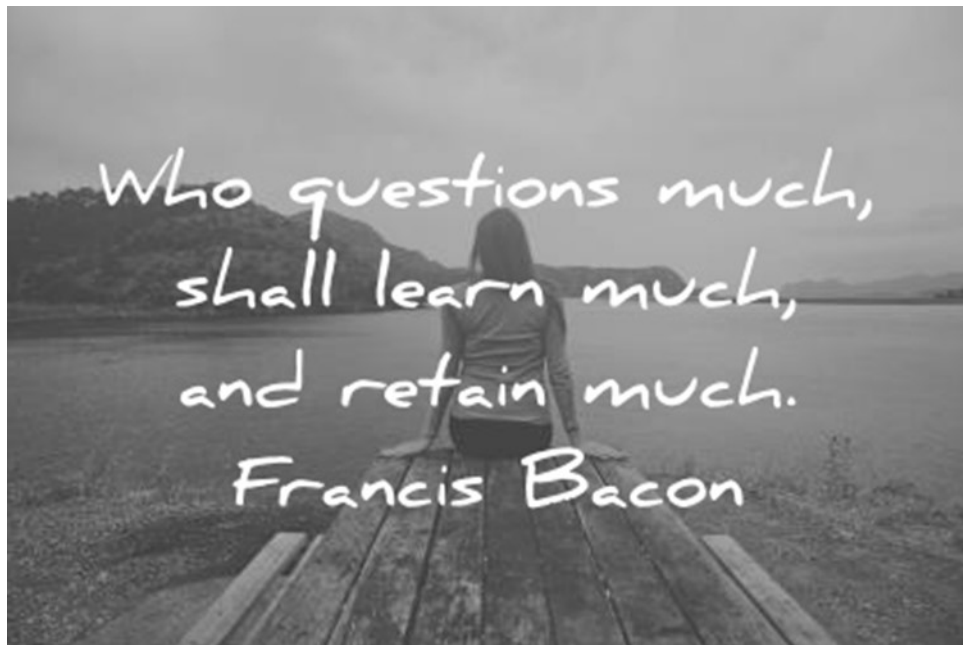

This Week at Fleetwood Park - Principal's Message: October 1st – 5th

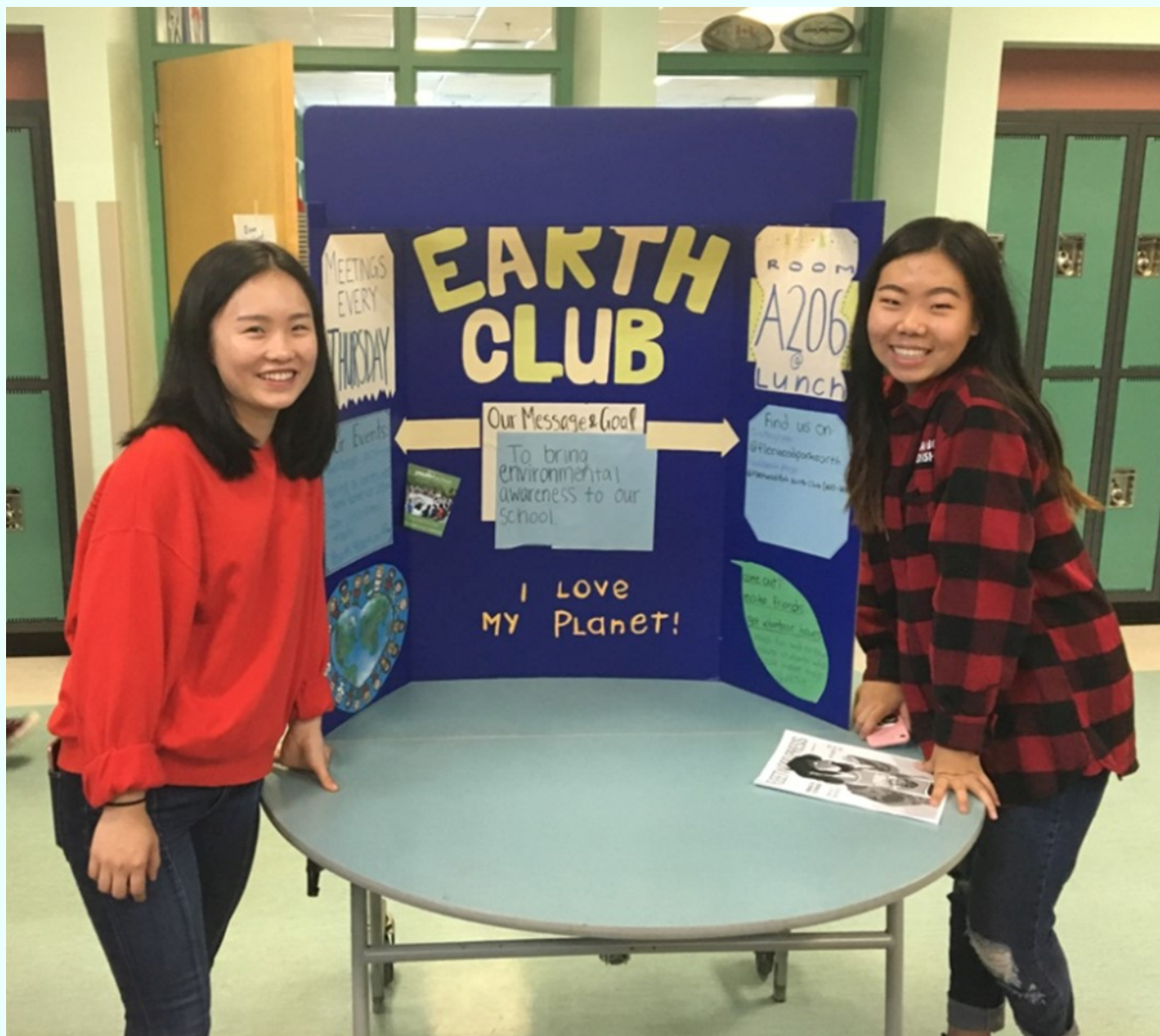
Good morning Dragons and welcome to October!
