# Principal's Message: November 27 - December 1st

It is the last day of November and we are in the final push to the Winter break. This is always a very busy and exciting time. Students and teachers are deeply engaged in their curriculum and many special events are scheduled over the next 3 weeks. During this time, we will be recognizing and celebrating our students' achievements and we know that these special events add to the rich tradition and culture of our school. 
