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

Good morning to all Fleetwood Park Secondary staff, students, parents and friends,

The school is now settling into the routines of the first semester. All but a few timetable adjustments have now been completed and students and teachers are well into their curriculum. Our current enrolment is now 1471 students and we have completed our staffing process for the Fall of 2017.
