Class division:

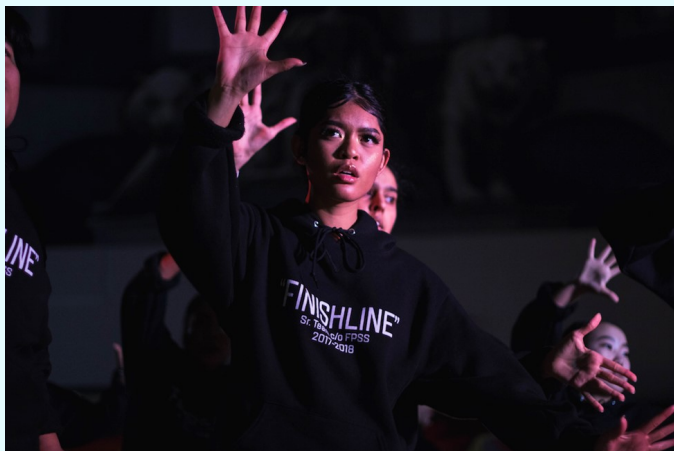
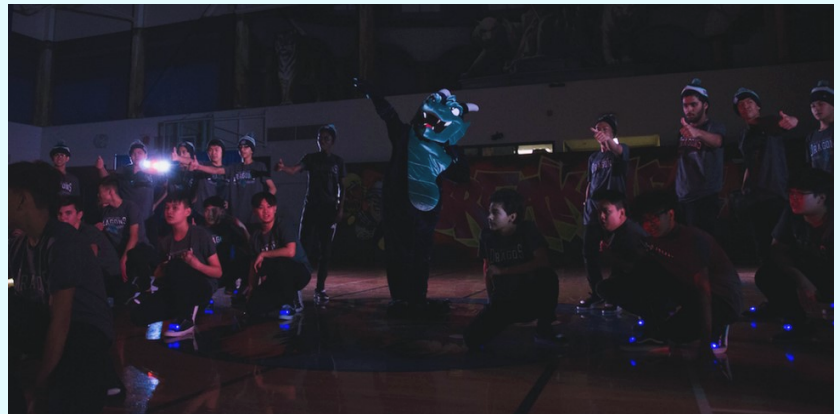
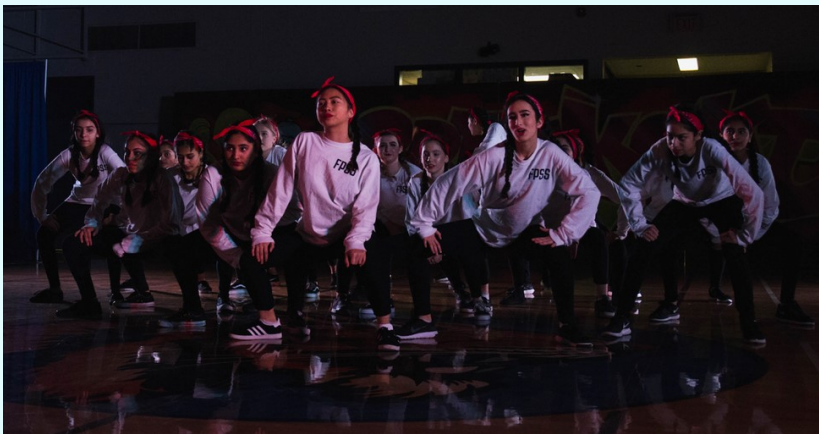
Beginner Class – Gr. 9,10 / Theme: "Free your mind" (of prejudice) - Silver ribbon (0.5 short of Gold)
