Overview

Each year, education bursaries are available through the Public Guardian and Trustee Educational Assistance Fund. The bursaries are intended to help individuals who were formerly in the permanent care of the provincial government reach their educational goals.

To be eligible for the bursary, you need to be:

- A former permanent ward of the Ministry of Social Services or
- Formerly in the continuing custody of the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) or a <u>Delegated Aboriginal Agency (DAA)/</u> <u>Indigenous Child and Family Service Agency</u> (<u>ICFSA</u>)

You must have been a permanent ward or in continuing custody until age 19.

You also need to be:

- · At least 19 years old
- · A high school graduate or equivalent
- Enrolled or planning to enroll in a postsecondary academic, technical or vocational program

The bursary is not to be your only source of funding. It is intended to cover shortfalls in your funds.
