Reporting Changes Grade 8/9

In anticipation to the change of the Ministry of Education's order on Reporting next year, some of our teachers are piloting a Standards-Based Grading Model. In order to do this, we are moving to a Single Term Report Card for all Grade 8 & 9's. This report card will look different than the traditional report card that students and parents are used to. For those classes that are using the Standards-Based Grading Model, parents may notice that students are receiving a mark based on a proficiency level (emerging = EMG / developing = DV / proficient = PR / extending = EXT) instead of a letter grade. Students in grade 8/9 classes not using a Standards-Based Grading model will only receive a letter grade and comment. In summary depending on the teacher, your child's first formal report card may be a combination of Letter Grades and Proficiency levels.

Reporting Grade 10-12

Report cards in Grade 10-12 will be similar to what they were in the past. All report cards will have a Percentage which converts to a Letter Grade, a Work Habit, and a comment.
