A word from your Principal

We have received so much financial support this year that directly impacts students' learning and growth. I want to highlight some of the many updates and improvements students have recently benefitted from:

- ✓ Physical plant updates happening over the summer and into the fall:
 - Exterior painting of the school (summer)
 - Interior painting of classrooms (summer)
 - Replacement of kindergarten washroom (summer)
 - Replacement of primary room sinks and countertops (summer)
- ✓ PAC Contributions:
 - \$5000 towards providing each classroom with a new ipad and sturdy case;

 - \$5700 to help cover fieldtrip costs


- Social and emotional needs
