Rosemary Heights Elementary Hot Lunch Program

Hello Parents!

Our parent volunteer group will continue to run the Hot Lunch program. All profits go back into funding various activities and items for our kids. Hot Lunch will be every Thursday. Hot Lunches are provided by **pre-order**. There is *no guarantee of same day concession sales*. We order according to the numbers in our system and we do our best to avoid waste and extra cost to the school by only ordering what we need.

- *Orders must be completed prior to Monday, February 7, 2022
- *First Hot Lunch this cycle **Thursday, March 3rd** (This order cycle will continue be from **March 3 to April 7, 2022**)

Due to the possibility of functional closures, we will be proceeding with ordering monthly vs. ordering for the remainder of the year. It is extremely important that all orders for March 3 to April 7 are entered into munchalunch as of **Monday, February 7.** If the school closes, hot lunch will be cancelled and a credit will appear on your account. In the unlikely event we are unable to cancel the order in time, we will arrange to have a pick up option for your order.

- Online ordering will be OPEN from January 31- February 7.

Please note if your child is ill on a lunch date, you are welcome to come and pick up their lunch by 12:00pm otherwise please consider it a donation for a child who does not have a lunch. Consistent with previous years, there are NO REFUNDS as this is a PAC fundraiser. We appreciate your support for our hot lunch program as the funds go towards general fundraising within the school.

Once an order has been placed and paid for, **you are unable to change or add to your order.** The system is easy to navigate but if you have any problems please email rosemaryhotlunch@gmail.com

Introducing Rocket Fuel:

The PAC's new Hot Lunch program for our Rosemary families who need a little help. Each week you will see a new menu item on your Hot Lunch order forms. Just click on ROCKET FUEL (\$5) and add it to your cart, and you will be providing a meal for a child who cannot afford one or simply does not have one. Each week we have children come to the kitchen needing food. Or teachers and staff requesting something for a student who comes to school with not enough. We want to support all of these children - because our Rosemary community is our family.

Zero Waste:

In our efforts to strive towards zero waste in our schools, we are asking you to pack cutlery with your child on our hot lunch days

PLEASE NOTE:

You may have noticed some prices have gone up to align with food cost increases by the vendor. Account Balances for Hot Lunch orders must be paid in full by February 7 for this month. Failure to pay your hot lunch balance will result in suspension of your order until the balance is paid.





Regarding Hot Lunch

Over the last few weeks we have seen a growing number of children come to the PAC kitchen asking for food. These students vary into 3 types:

- 1. Students who don't have a lunch for whatever reason and are hungry.
- 2. Students who's parents did not order them a Hot Lunch and don't like there's.
- 3. Students who are trying to score free food.

We are hoping you can speak to your kids about their Hot Lunch. Each week you get a email letting you know what you ordered for your child. Please communicate to them what indeed they should be expecting. We spend a tonne of time looking up individual orders because a child is certain they ordered a cookie and did not receive it.

99% of the time the orders are handed out correctly with no discrepancies as we triple check the orders and the forms.

But of course there are mistakes as we are all human and we always want to make sure kids are getting what they ordered.

And a message to the students who come down hoping to get a free bag of chips or a chocolate milk. Know that each time you misrepresent yourself to receive a free snack or meal, that's just one less for a child that actually needs it. At the end of the lunch hour we don't have many leftovers and in most cases we sell out.

Parents please speak to your students about these points. We will be now sending notes home to parents if we run into an issue with your child at Hot Lunch.

Having said all of that. Please be assured, no child who expresses hunger will be turned away.
