2024 COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Rotary Club of White Rock (<https://www.whiterockrotary.org/>) invites application for post-secondary scholarships. There are **four individual scholarships of \$3,000** each for students graduating in 2024.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants attend one of the following schools: **Earl Marriott Secondary, Elgin Park Secondary, Grandview Heights Secondary, Panorama Ridge Secondary, Semiahmoo Secondary, Southridge, South Surrey/White Rock Learning Centre, White Rock Christian Academy.**
2. Applicants must be planning to attend full-time studies at a post-secondary institution during 2024-25. The post-secondary program can be either academic or trades training. Scholarships are payable on proof of full-time registration at a post-secondary institution.
3. Applicants must be current full time Grade 12 students.
4. Applicants must hold a Canadian SIN card.

CRITERIA

The Rotary Club of White Rock is a volunteer service club. As such the Scholarship Committee will consider applicants' demonstrated commitment to volunteer and service activities in the community. Scholarships will be awarded based on evaluation of the following criteria:

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| 1. Scholastic and Extra-curricular (e.g. sports, music, arts) Achievements | 20% |
| 2. Academic and Personal References | 15% |
| 3. Demonstration of Contribution to Community | 30% |
| 4. Financial Need | 20% |
| 5. Future Goals and Ambitions | 10% |

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Submissions must include:

1. Completed 2024 Community Scholarship Application form (attached).
2. Cover letter or personal essay of up to 500 words, as to why they should be chosen as a recipient.
3. Copy of the applicant's academic transcripts.
4. One academic/school reference letter.
5. One personal reference letter.
6. Optional submission may include a brief portfolio of not more than five (5) pages, outlining their individual experience, accomplishments and commitment to volunteer and community service.
