Principal's Update - Renna Gill

- Electric Keyboard (Music Teacher) Estimated cost: \$700 1st Jennifer, 2nd Megan, all in favour. Approved.
- Tennis Excel Program \$9.45per student. Every child gets 4 lessons (April 4-13).
 Estimated cost: \$3,500 1st Jennifer, 2nd Sharon, all in favour. Approved.
- Sporting Equipment RS ordered \$3,000 worth of gym equipment at the beginning of the year. Volleyballs are on back order, but volleyball practices have started. Requesting 6-10 volleyballs as well as bins to hold all new equipment. Estimated cost: \$500 1st Nicole, 2nd Ali, all in favour. Approved.
