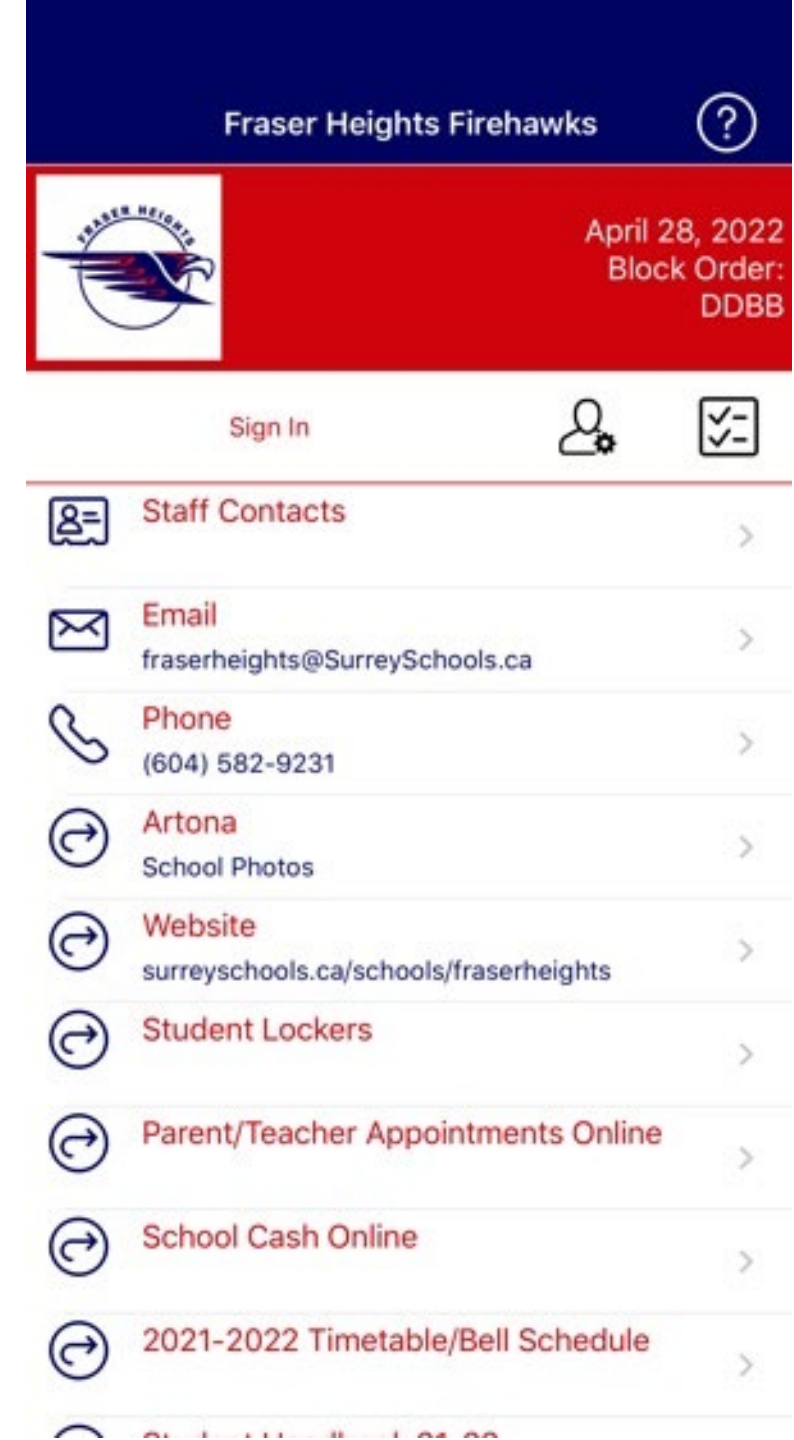

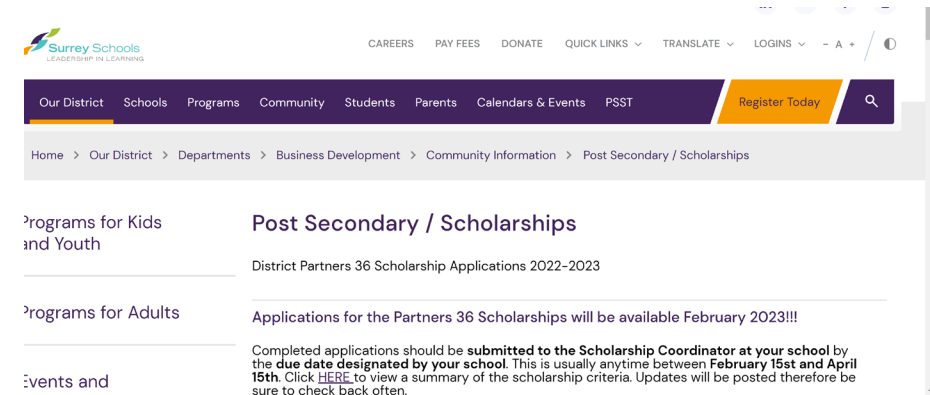

School Scholarship Information

- There are two parts to your application
 1. The online application (A form that will be sent out to you virtually)
 2. Teacher Reference

Both of these items are **required** to be considered for a scholarship



The Fraser Heights Scholarship Application

- In your application, you may indicate interest in being considered for a District Authority Scholarship (worth \$1250 each)
- Awards excellence in one of seven non-academic areas of interest

Area of Achievement	Example
Indigenous Language & Culture	Demonstrated at school or community
Fine Arts	Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music
Applied Design & Technologies	Business, technology, Home Ec, Information Communication Technology
Physical Activity	Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, PHE
International Languages	International language classes, external assessment
Community Service	Volunteer work including awareness of local, global and cultural issues
Technical and Trades Training	Automotive, Robotics, Coding, Woodwork, Culinary Arts

- Tell us about yourself
- How will this scholarship make a difference for you
- Tell us about a time you failed and what you learned from that experience
- Tell us about a contribution you have made to your community
- Academic/professional goals
- Examples of leadership
- Biggest influence in your life
- Why you deserve this scholarship



How Do I Get Chosen?

- **Sell yourself**
 - Tell the truth, but don't downplay
- **Scholarship donors are investing in you**
 - What makes you a good investment

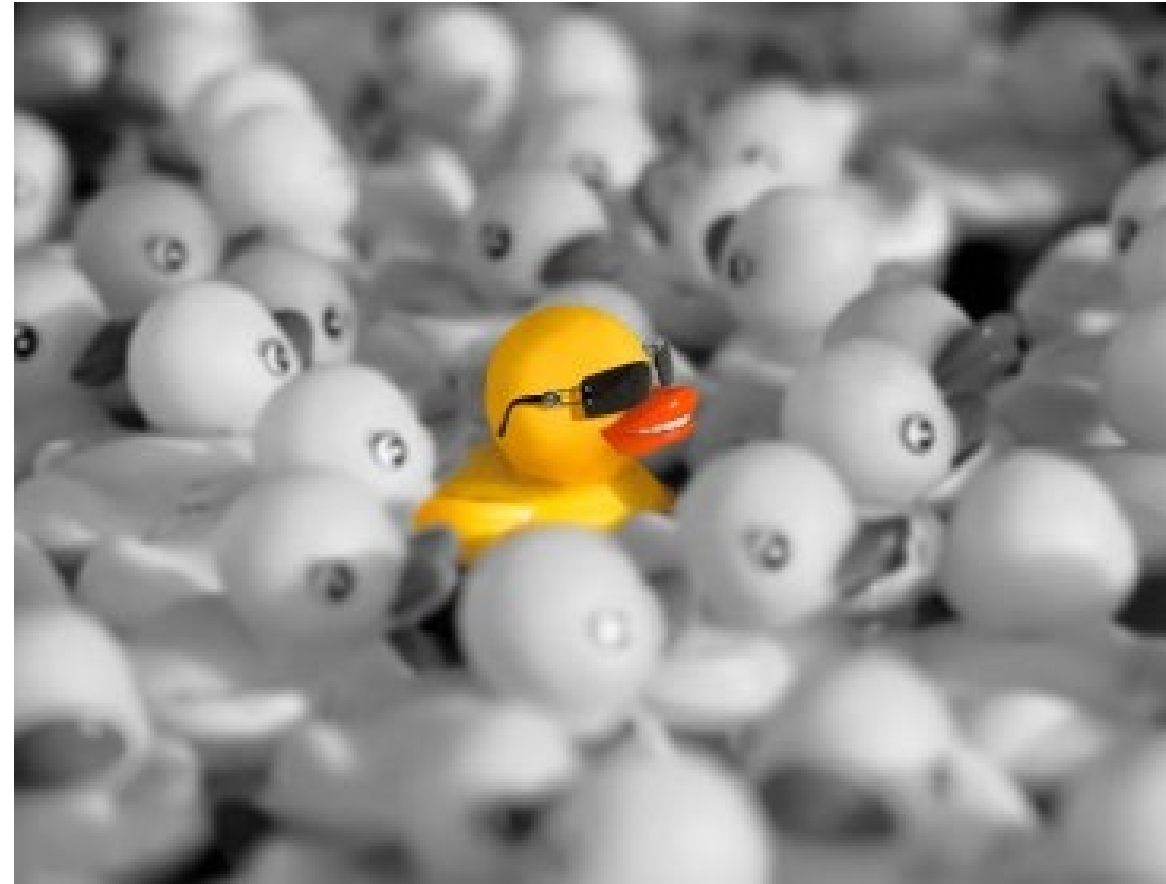


Achievement

Some tips on planning...

Think about yourself (What type of person are you? Strengths/weakness?)

What evidence/examples do you have?

Resume (you should have one...what have you done)

Few other tips and tricks

- **Apply, apply apply!**
 - o Many go unclaimed each year!
- **Be informed**
 - o Do you meet requirements, be realistic
- **Respect deadlines**
 - o Set a calendar
- **Review your documents**
 - o spelling/grammar
- **Think of it as applying for a job**
 - o What makes you unique
