

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The dress code has been developed through discussions with staff and the Parent's Advisory Council. We have found it helpful to provide students with guidelines for dressing appropriately at school. We believe that school should be treated as "their place of business".

We ask that students refrain from wearing these types of items:

- t-shirts or accessories with negative or inappropriate symbols, pictures or slogans
- short shorts or skirts (length to be below finger tips when hands by sides)
- spaghetti strap or strapless tops
- midriff tops, (if the arms are raised shirts should cover midriff area)
- low rise jeans/pants that don't meet the top
- visible undergarments

Students may be asked to change or wear school provided acceptable clothing.

In addition, the following items should NOT be worn inside the school building:

- hats, caps, hoods or visors, roller shoes/rollerblades

Please also ensure that children are dressed appropriately for **daily** physical activity (ie. running shoes) and are prepared and dressed for inclement weather (hats, gloves, jackets, boots).
