Dear Parents/Guardians,

Each school year, parents support their child(ren)'s formal learning experience in a wide variety of ways. We so appreciate all that you do to ensure a successful year!

In addition to providing the school supplies itemized on a grade list, parents are periodically asked for monies to cover specific items and/or special events. No student will be denied the opportunity to participate in any activity that is necessary to cover curricular requirements.

As we plan for the 2020/2021 school year, we anticipate the following costs:

Student Planner: In the past we have encouraged all students in Grades 1-7 to purchase a School Planner in September, however, at this time we don't know what September will look like and Planner orders are on hold.

Field Studies and Field Trips: On occasion educational field trips are offered to students which extend and enhance the curriculum. While we use school monies or fundraise to cover the costs of such activities wherever possible, there are times when parents are asked to contribute towards the cost of the trip. If you choose to have your child not participate in a field study, a suitable program will be provided at the school.

Musical Instruments: Our Grade 7 students who take band can either purchase or rent an instrument. Costs vary depending on the instrument.

School Supplies: In the past parents have had the option to purchase school supplies as a package from Creative Children however, at this time, we do not know what September will look like so school supplies and school supply lists are on hold until we have more information. Kindergarten parents will receive a summer mailer (which may be delayed until more information is available) with details outlining the kindergarten supplies which will be bought in bulk and not run more than \$40.
