

Connecting to the New SD36 Network for Guest Users

Step 1: On your personal device, connect to the network named, SD36.

Step 2: Launch an Internet Browser (IE. Chrome, Safari or Edge)

Note: Certain devices will automatically open a browser.

Step 3: Navigate to the SD36 Captive Portal (Figure A)

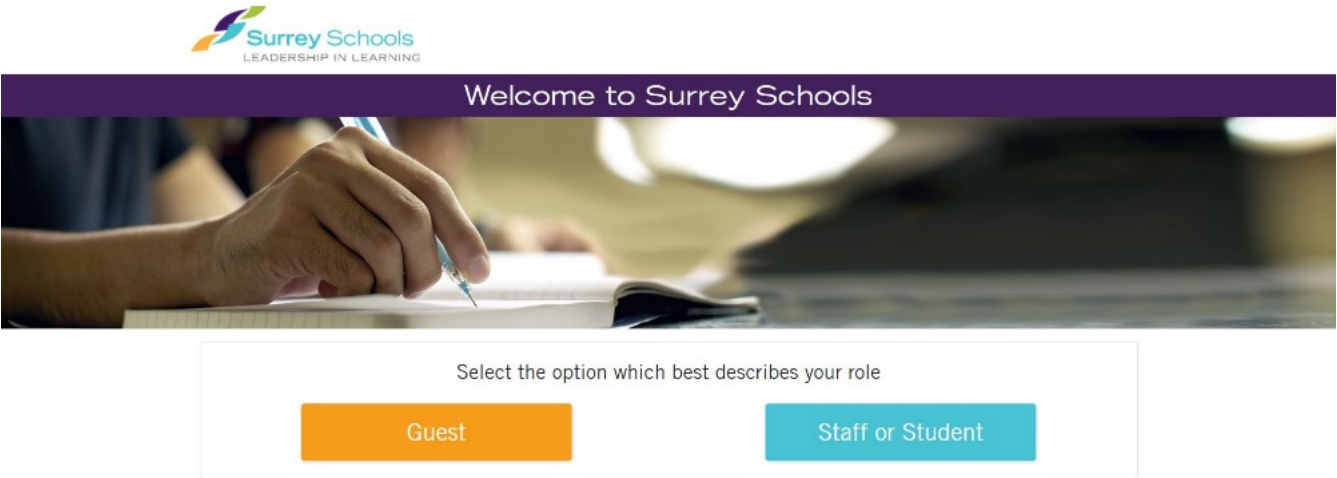

Skip to Step 4 if a browser automatically opens and is already at the SD36 Captive Portal. Otherwise:

Safari (Apple Devices such as iPhone/iPad/MacBook)

Navigate to any website. Preferably a website you do not commonly visit (IE. Cheese.com).

If you encounter a website stating, “This Connection Is Not Private,” similar to Figure B:

- Tap/Click Show Details
- Tap/Click Visit this website (bottom of page)
- Tap/Click Visit Website
- The SD36 Captive Portal should now load

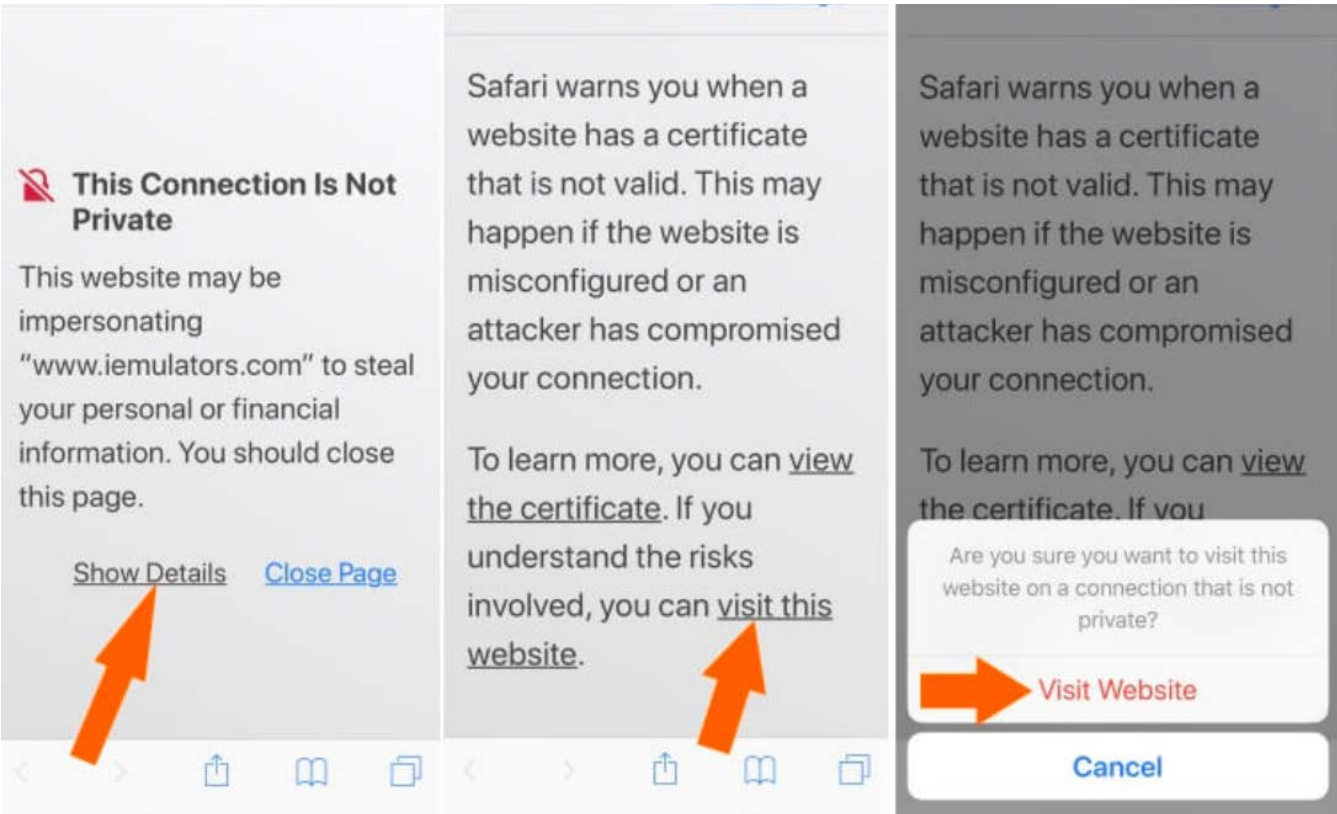

Chrome (Android or Laptop devices)

Navigate to any website. Preferably a website you do not commonly visit (IE. Cheese.com)

If you encounter a website stating, “Your connection is not private,” similar to Figure C:

- Tap/Click Advanced
- Tap/Click Proceed to <website link>
- The SD36 Captive Portal should now load

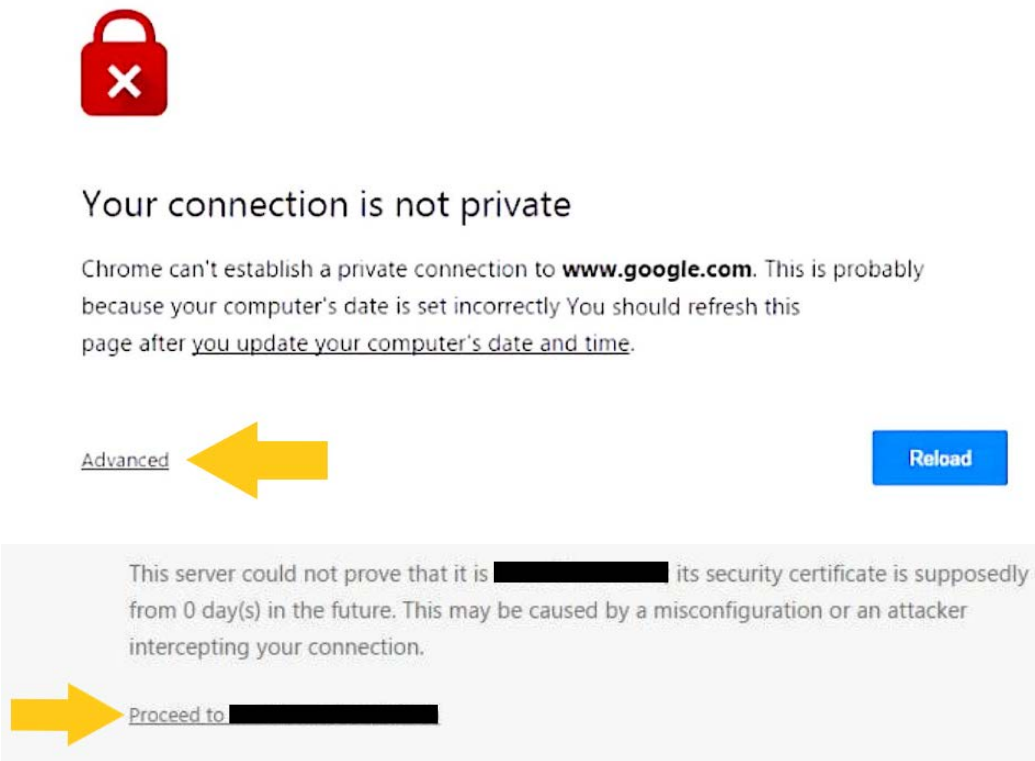

Edge (Windows devices)

Navigate to any website. Preferably a website you do not commonly visit (IE. Cheese.com)

If you encounter a website stating, “Your connection is not private,” similar to Figure D:

- Click “Continue to this webpage (not recommended)”
- The SD36 Captive Portal should now load

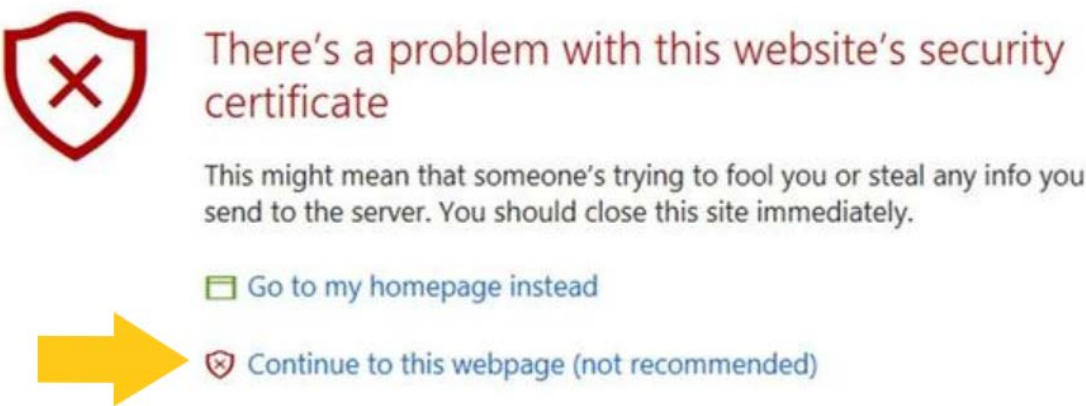

Step 4: Select Guest (Figure D)

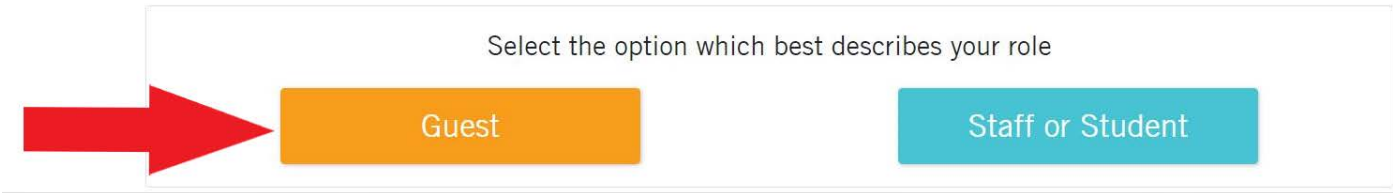

Step 5: On the Guest Login page, register for an account by selecting "Click Here" under "Need an account? Click Here to register" (Figure E).

Step 6: On the next page, fill out the necessary fields: Name, E-Mail Address, Mobile Phone Number and check the box to confirm that you agree to the Surrey School District acceptable use policy, then click Register (Figure F).

Step 7. The Mobile phone number entered in the account will receive an SMS message with a username and password (Figure G). The username is the E-Mail address provided in the Guest Account form.

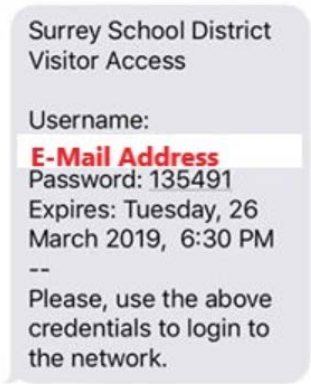


