President's Report:

I want to start by thanking you all for joining us today. Your support and presence here indicates the positive steps we have taken in the right direction.

As in previous years, through the various fundraisers we had we were able to provide funding for Field Trips, Classroom incentives, Art Start program, Textbooks, Sports Equipment, Technology e-devices etc.

This year we utilized the volunteer parents to organize & order the hot lunches. I want to thank specially Prabhjot Kaur, Avneet Kaur, Sukhi & others who volunteered their time in sorting, counting the hot lunch orders.

Our school population is growing. Trying to represent our parent population and provide fun to our students is becoming more challenging every year. It's not easy to find opportunities that can encompass all of our students at once and it's harder to find volunteers for some events. More parent volunteer participation will be appreciated. In a school that has 567 students, we end up with the same base 5-10 volunteers, if we are lucky. In order for events and fundraisers to continue, we need to think of more ways to recruit more parents. Though this is not isolated to our school, it becomes an issue when it's always the same people being expected to sacrifice their time – everyone is busy. If volunteer apathy continues, the few volunteers who continuously give their time and energy will burn out.

We have been trying to alert our neighbors to keeping an eye on the school building after hours to keep **vandalism** to a minimum.

The parents continue to promote **traffic safety** on the way to and from school. PAC & Parents had meetings with local MLA, City of Surrey Engineering Department about this issue. We have also asked the school district via principal to make improvements in the parking area.

Now I want to talk about after school programs:

Our After School Program Coordinators I, myself and our school principal Ms Lise Schrag have again done a great job to organize and make available two rounds of after school dance and athletic opportunities this year. The program continues to be very popular. The after school programs are intended to be an additional educational and inspirational chance for all students, and we run them at no cost; making a 100% profit where instructors donate their time to the PAC. The instructor was our school's past student & currently enrolled in high school. We want to encourage more high school students to be role models & give back to their past elementary schools. The money raised this way is made available for the benefits of all students. Looking forward to a new fall program, we will keep parents informed.

We would love to start more programs if any parent has the time & skill to run educational or athletic program, please let us know. Specially The Health and Safety Coordinator who can bring in experts from the outside to hold **workshops for pre-teen girls and boys**, promoting a healthy self-image and resistance to gangs, bullying and abuse.

I would like to thank everyone for their hard work and contributions this year. The students couldn't have enjoyed all the extras without the dedication and commitment of our volunteers.

An extra special thanks to my executive. It makes my job that much easier knowing that I have a team like you guys. As it has been my allotted 2 years, I am stepping down as President. It's been my pleasure to work with you all.
