UPDATED COVID GUIDELINES AT NORTH RIDGE

Students:

- Grade 4~7 students must wear masks while inside except during intense physical activity in the gym.
- Kindergarten to Grade 3 students are highly encouraged to wear a mask.
- Masks are optional outside.
- Although the 2 metre distancing rule is no longer in effect, students are encouraged to maintain their personal space.
- Students will continue last year's increased handwashing routines: washing or sanitizing hands before and after going outside, going to another room in the school, before and after eating, after using the washroom.
- Students are not allowed to share food under any circumstance.
- Any student or staff experiencing Covid symptoms must stay home and are recommended to get a Covid test. If your child starts experiencing symptoms at school, we will call you to pick up your child.

Staff:

• All staff are always required to wear a mask while indoors except when eating, at their workstation or working alone.

Parents/Visitors:

- We welcome visitors into the building by appointment only as we must have strict sign-in procedures for Covid-19 tracking purposes.
- Please have your child bring their lunch in their backpack in the morning when coming to school. Due to Covid-19 safety precautions, we ask that parents do not drop off lunches at the office mid-day unless your child has forgotten their lunch.
- Parents are not allowed to bring food to school for other children. Hot Lunch days may happen this school year, but the items will be individually wrapped and provided by a food-safe vendor.

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Cleaning Procedures:

All high touch surfaces such as doorknobs, desks, washrooms, phones, etc. will be cleaned once a day. Each room in the school will be sprayed every evening with a Clorox 360 disinfectant.

STUDENT PLANNERS

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The Surrey School District does not insure expenses for student injuries that happen on school grounds or during school activities, and MSP limits the amounts paid or does not cover some charges.

Parents have the option to purchase student accident insurance for injury-related costs not covered or limited under MSP or group insurance plans. These costs may include:

- Dental treatment
- Eyewear
- Rental of crutches or wheelchairs
- Splints and casts
- Physiotherapy
- Ambulance transportation
- Private tutoring and counselling

Optional student accident insurance is available through private companies and interested parents are encouraged to research which plan best suits their family's needs.

Surrey Schools has made available information on student accident insurance through Insure my kids and Study Insured Student Accident. This coverage is available for purchase online, families can voluntarily purchase accident insurance through the "Insure my Kids" and "Study Insured Student Accident" programs.

Yearly plans cost between \$13 (lite), \$17 (Silver), \$25 (Gold/Plus) and \$33 (Platinum/Premium), providing a full year of coverage 24 hours a day, whether at school or at home. A discounted premium is may be available for families with three or more children.
