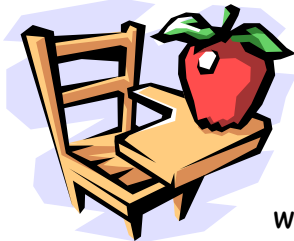

Welcome Window



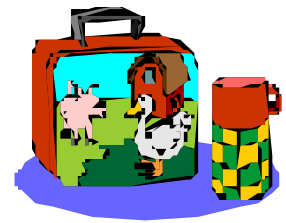
There will be a welcoming window from 8:35 am - 8:45 am (classroom doors remain open during this time) for staggered student arrival. Students do not line up outside the classroom and will come right in, hang backpacks, wash hands (one by one) and find their seats. After 8:45 am, students should knock on the external classroom door and will be let into the room.

The first half hour of the school day is when teachers outline activities and discuss their expectations for the day. It is crucial that students be present for these important instructions.

Regular attendance and being on time are two important factors in a student's school life. It is also an important life skill to have.

Litterless Lunches

Please send a pre-packaged lunch and snack that are self-contained or pack in/pack out. To help ensure safety and minimize touching of shared surfaces, **compost and recycling will not be available at the school**. Your child will need to bring the items home to be composted. For example, if your child has a yoghurt container, this will need to be put in their lunch bag and brought home. Please ensure your child has all of their lunch/snack containers and water bottles labelled with their first and last names. Please also send a filled water bottle with your child daily. Our bottle filling fountain is operational but the water fountain is not. Due to COVID Health and Safety guidelines, at this time there will be no drop off for hot lunches or sharing of treats for birthdays.



Parents, if you would like to take your child home for lunch, please check into the office by knocking on the door and signing your child out on a clipboard we will hand to you. You will need to remain outside. We will then call your child down. When your child returns, please bring them to the office to sign in. Thank you parents for your support.

Safety Reminders

Parents are expected to self-monitor their children for flu - like symptoms and complete a health check each morning before school.



Proper handwashing is the best way to prevent the spread of infection. Proper hand washing reduces the spread of colds and influenza by as much as 40%! When you wash your hands, you wash away the germs that you may have picked up from other people, from surfaces, or from animals. Remind your children to wash their hands thoroughly and often, so that hand washing becomes a life-long habit. As soon as they get home from school or the mall, encourage them to wash their hands. Washing hands before meals is also very important.

Parking & Traffic Information

The drop off zone is for quick drop offs and pick-ups. Please do not leave your car unattended or use this area for parking. Please avoid driving your car into our parking lot after school if possible in order to cut down the congestion as some staff members are leaving the lot. There is a one-way route you need to follow by staying to the RIGHT if you have to enter our lot. Stay to the right and make the loop.
