Elementary Transition

On August 26th, the Surrey School District shared its <u>plans</u> to safely return to in-class instruction. These plans reflect the measures put forth by provincial health experts and the Ministry of Education and include the important steps our schools will take to safely welcome our students back in September.

We are confident in our plans, but we know that many of our families are nervous. In response to parent feedback and concerns, we will be offering an <u>Elementary Transition Program</u> that will be available to all families who are not yet ready to have their child return to full-time face-to-face instruction when school begins in September.

This program is a combination of online and face-to-face learning through your local school, with a gradual transition back to full time in-class instruction by January 2021.

First Week Back Orientation Schedule

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Students who are returning full time will attend school for a one hour orientation session each day on Thursday September 10th and Friday September 11th according to the schedule below.

9:00 - 10:00 Grades 1, 2, 3, 4


11:00 - 12:00 Grades 5, 6, 7

On September 10th and 11th students will meet in grade groups on the gravel field. Staff will be on hand to direct students and ensure physical distancing. Please be aware to maintain physical distancing with other families when at school.

Monday September 14th will be the first full day of school for students. Students in Grade 1-3 will attend from 8:30-2:35 and students in grades 4-7 will start 30 minutes later and attend from 9:00-2:35.

Kindergarten students will receive information about their gradual entry schedule in a separate email before the first week of school.

Students who are enrolled in the elementary transition program receive an orientation during the week of September 14th.
