INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL:	WHAT TO DO
Have you returned from travel outside Canada in the last 14 days?	If yes: All students and staff who have travelled outside of Canada are required to self-quarantine for 14 days after arrival under both provincial and federal orders. This includes students who are attending school from abroad. Students from outside of Canada should plan to arrive in Canada at least two weeks before they are scheduled to attend school to adhere to the self-quarantine orders. CLOSE CONTACT	WHAT TO DO
Have you been contacted by public health and notified that you are a close contact of a person confirmed to have COVID-19?	If yes: Please follow the instructions provided by Public Health. If it becomes harder to breathe, you can't drink anything or feel much worse, seek urgent medical care at an urgent care clinic or emergency department.

Back to School Shopping and our Dress Code

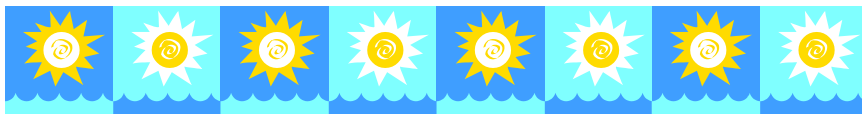
As you head out for back to school shopping, please keep in mind

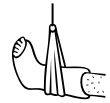

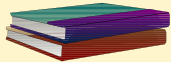


LTSS LIBRARY SERVICES



Something for everyone! Students are encouraged to visit the library to study, research, surf the web, or read for pleasure. We would like the library to be an important part of every student's education and school life. In addition to our extensive collection of fiction and non-fiction books we subscribe to approximately 60 magazines and 2 daily newspapers. The loan period for books is 3 weeks, magazines for 1 week, and reference materials may be borrowed overnight. Your "GO" card bearing your student number is your library card.

Overdue Policy: If you have an overdue item, you are not permitted to sign out anything else until the item has been returned or renewed. If you still need items which have reached their loan due date, please bring them to the circulation counter for renewal. Students are responsible for the replacement cost of all lost or damaged books.



PICKING YOUR CHILD UP BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL

Traffic Congestion Before and After School

Parents have expressed a concern about the traffic congestion around Lord Tweedsmuir before and after school. The number of cars and buses has created a safety hazard. To ensure the safety of students and school visitors, we ask for your cooperation:

1. **DO NOT** enter via the Handicap and Bus Pick-up zones and be mindful that there is no stopping in front of the flag island.
2. **DO NOT** double park in the turnaround zone as this prevents other parents and visitors from entering and leaving.
3. **DO NOT** block the entrance or exit to the school. Even if this area is only partially blocked, it creates difficulties for buses who need to negotiate the turn.
4. If you have entered the school lot, please do not park in the yellow zone. This is for buses and emergency vehicles only!
5. If possible, arrange for a meeting place with your child(ren) a short distance from the school.
6. Please allow vehicles attempting to leave the school to do so.
7. Please allow handicapped students extra time to cross the street. Do not attempt to steer around them.
8. Please be aware that the speed along 180th Street is 50 km, and it is a motor vehicle offense to pass a vehicle to the right on the shoulder of the road.
9. Please respect the pedestrians in the crosswalk located on 180th in front of the school.



LTSS COUNSELLING DEPARTMENT

STUDENT USE OF TECHNOLOGY

An ever increasing number of students are using Information Technology to share work between home and school.

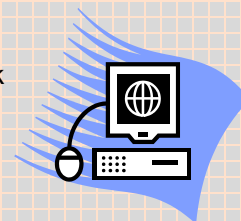
There are school email addresses for every student if they need to share their documents between home and school. Students can also use services such as google, hot mail, or personal email accounts.

Obstacles still exist that can be avoided with a little advance planning.

1. Make sure that documents are saved to the school's standard. We are currently using Office 2016 as our base system. If you have the newer version of Word or Word Perfect make sure to Save As and change the file type to at least the 2016 version of Word.
2. Students can also bring their documents to school on a portable USB storage device.

With these difficulties taken care of, students should be able to successfully transfer work between home and school. Students are also advised to try to complete their transfers ahead of the due date so that if there are any unforeseen problems they can be dealt with in advance.

Every student has a computer account with the school district for local file storage. If user name and passwords are required, please see the office.

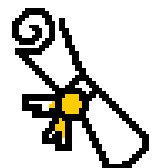

Step 3: Once you have completed registration for a BCeID account, you can continue to Student Transcripts and fill out your student information to access your transcripts.

Do not forget to back in and select all the post secondary schools you want your interim and final marks to be sent

Online student accounts have been created for all current students. To log in, you must enter your **STUDENT #** and your **password**.

After entering your **STUDENT #**, you must enter your **password**. Your password is your birthday. The format of the password is YYYYMMDD, so if you were born Sept 19, 2004, your password would be '20040919'.

Select a **zone of the school** in which you would like to have a locker. Note that as the availability of lockers changes, the zone buttons will change from **Yellow** (many lockers available), to **Orange** (over 50% of lockers capacity assigned) to **Red** (no lockers available in zone).

When a zone is selected, the available lockers will be listed. A locker entry that is **Green** is an available locker, and a locker entry that is **Orange** is NOT available.

Once you have selected a locker you will be given the **locker combination**. You can log in at any time to see your assigned locker and combination.

Note: *You cannot change your locker through the online application.*

All GRADE 8 STUDENTS: Your student number is included with the information in this mail out (listed on your schedule).

LOCKER AREAS: There are 3 floors at LTSS. If you go to this web site above before the date below, you can check out the locker areas and start to pre-plan where you may like to have a locker.

UPPER LOCKERS: These lockers are for grades 10, 11 and 12 students only and are **odd numbered**.

LOWER LOCKERS: These are available to all students and are even numbered.

Dates when students can start to access the system for 2021/2022 school year:

Grade 12: Monday, August 30 @ 10:00 am

Grade 8: Tuesday, August 31 @ 10:00 am

Grade 11: Wednesday, September 1 @ 10:00 am

Grades 9 & 10: Thursday, September 2 @ 10:00 am

Please note, it is the student's responsibility to ensure they have logged in and selected their locker on or after the given date.
