# **STUDENT ORIENTATION**

During the student orientation you can expect a warm welcome back from our staff who will provide an opportunity to establish connections, excitement, and a sense of belonging! During this orientation students will be organized into groups and will have the opportunity to connect with each of the teachers at their grade level, on a rotation, throughout the first few days. We will do our best to have classes established by the end of week one.

In addition to some review and teambuilding exercises, we will cover important health and safety topics and information about new school routines including:

- Reassurance and kindness from our staff
- Welcome, ease concerns, address any questions
- Safety protocols and expectations
- Arrival and dismissal
- Washroom procedures
- Play areas
- Lunch procedures



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#### **RETURN TO SCHOOL SAFETY PLANNING**

Here are some of the ways we are planning for a safe return to school:

- Please be reminded that <u>parents and caregivers are responsible to assess their child(ren) each day before</u> going to school. If your child is experiencing symptoms of common cold, influenza, COVID-19 or other infectious respiratory disease please <u>keep your child home until the symptoms have resolved.</u>
- All students, staff and family members must stay home if they are sick and not enter the school building.
- Minimizing physical contact where possible.
- Regular, scheduled hand washing and hand sanitizing.
- Reduced and directional hallway traffic keep right.
- Masks worn in school at all times by staff and students in Grades 4-7, and strongly recommended for students in Grades K 3.
- Re-usable masks are available in the office upon request.
- Increased outdoor learning and play (dress appropriately for the weather).
- Shared materials may be used with regular handwashing and cleaning.
- No sharing of food including snacks, lunch, and birthday treats.

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- Parents/visitors are welcome at the office this year. All visitors must wear a mask, sanitize, and sign

- No lunches should be dropped off at the office during the school day. Please send lunch to school with your child(ren) in the morning.
- Students will be going outside rain or shine most days, so please dress appropriately for all weather.

#### **CLASS PLACEMENTS AND STAFFING**

We ask for your patience and understanding as we place students into classes. The first several days students will be rotating in groups to meet all the teachers at their grade level while classes are determined. We will do our best to get students into classes by Friday, September 10.

#### **SCHOOL SUPPLIES**

School Supply lists for Grades K-7 are posted on our website. Students will not need to bring any supplies for the first days next week.

# **ALLERGY AWARENESS**

Several Royal Heights students have severe anaphylactic reactions to peanuts, nuts and their by-products. Please do not send foods to school that contain these products. Children will not be sharing any food and will be washing their hands carefully after eating if there is an anaphylactic student in your child's classroom. Thank you for your continued understanding and cooperation as we endeavour to make our school a safe environment for all students.
