A Word from Your Principal

Each year we tend to forget all the moving parts needed to help ensure we get off to a strong start. With an incredibly dedicated and talented staff, beautiful grounds, and spirited children, we've lifted off and are ready to soar. It has been a fantastic start to the school year.

One of the significant changes to our start up compared to last year is that we are no longer required to remain in learning cohorts. As guided by provincial health orders, regional protocols and district standards, we are able to slowly welcome back many traditions and activities that have put on hold for nearly 18 months. These include:

- opportunities for student leadership (e.g. lunch monitors, big buddies, and fundraising);
- gathering face to face for small primary and intermediate assemblies in the gym;
- resuming sports teams;
- PAC hot lunches (with restrictions)

Some practices remain the same as when we left in June:

- masks are required when indoors for all students in grades 4-7 and for all staff;
- any visitor is required to wear a mask when in the school;
- masks are encouraged when indoors for children in grades 1-3;
- hand hygiene protocols remain vigilant;
- all staff and students are required perform the **Daily Health Check** and are required to remain home if not feeling well.
