The teachers have made every attempt to create balanced classes that keep learners social emotional and academic needs in mind. For some children, a new classroom with new children is concerning. Please help your child accept that change is a part of growth and instill in them a belief that they have the ability to handle new situations.

Outdoor Area Updates



EKOLogy East Kensington Outdoor Learning Program O G y



Stop by and see how the wetland has evolved over the course of a year! Last September it was an area with dirt and gravel and low water in the one pond. This year we have three little ponds, and the areas surrounding the ponds are a riot of tall clover and thriving willow saplings. There is evidence of snakes living in the wetland which must mean there is a whole little ecosystem hidden in there! I can't wait to take the children into the wetland and see what they notice in nature!

In early July staff came to complete some outdoor projects. You will notice **new tables and benches** in the Pergola and two new **mud kitchens** along the fence. We are sure the children will enjoy learning in the Pergola and will explore the properties of nature and dramatic play in the mud kitchens!

The new raised garden beds have managed to support most of the plants we set in June. There are still a few little tomatoes, some herbs, asparagus and lettuce thriving. A possible reason the other plants that did not quite survive the summer is that we planted too late in the season. But we plant and learn! I was pleased to see that the soil moisture was well maintained due to the nature of the special raised beds with reservoirs. Thank you to all the families who came out to weed, clean up and water the gardens over the summer. Hopefully you took advantage of some little veggie treats.

Mr. Baldry and I are currently in talks with the district about planting a little **forest** as an extension of the wetland ecosystem. We are exploring the feasibility of this project concerning funding, planting and maintenance. I think this will be a focus for improvement of our outdoor learning spaces this year and I look forward to coordinating efforts between district staff, school staff, parents and students in making this a reality!

Kindergarten supplies have already been purchased for the class at a cost to each student of \$45.00. We are a cashless school which means **all payments for fieldtrips, student**


What Is School Cash Online?

PARKING SAFETY

Please enter the parking lot through the 28th Avenue entrance. Exit out the 184th Street access. Please **turn off your cars** while you wait to avoid exhaust fumes. It is school district policy that **prohibits smoking** of any substances on or near school grounds.



When you take your child to school, remember to press the crosswalk button, watch that cars have actually stopped, then walk your children across the crosswalk. Avoid walking through the staff parking lot. Walk your child along the pathway to the undercover area to keep them safe from cars.

If you have concerns about the safety of our crosswalk, please contact the City of Surrey to request that they paint school zone signs directly on the road. I have already asked for that from the city and have called the RCMP about traffic safety, but the more we let the city know that this is an issue, the better.

Traffic Reminders:

Please park in the lot across the street from the school and then walk your child across the crosswalk with the guidance of Janice our wonderful crossing guard.

The parking lot close to the school is for staff parking.
