

# SKILLED TRADES CO-OP

Skilled Trades Co-op is designed to give students an opportunity to explore and gain hands-on skills in a variety of Red Seal trade areas, such as mechanics, electrical, plumbing, carpentry, metal fabrication, and welding. Ideally, this program is taken in grade 11 in preparation for the District Youth Train in Trades programs. By successfully completing the program, students will earn 24 credits and complete their ADST requirements.

Students should be mature, independent, and hard-working. There is a mandatory application that requires recommendations from an elective teacher.

## EXPECTATIONS:

Regular attendance is critical due to the condensed nature of the course work. Students will be expected to manage both curricular and workplace requirements with maturity, professionalism, and responsibility acting as excellent ambassadors of Earl Marriott.
