## STEP BY STEP GUIDE TO APPLYING FOR A POST SECONDARY INSTITUTION

- 1. Decide where you want to attend-- university/college. Most students pick 2 or 3 institutions.
- 2. Try and visit the campus if at all possible. Most universities/colleges offer tours.
- 3. Attend any University/College presentations at EMS to get more information and your questions answered.
- 4. Attend the BC Post Secondary Institution (PSI) evening and Canadian Universities Event (CUE).
- Familiarize yourself with the admission requirements for the School and Faculty you plan to apply to.
- 6. Pay attention to the application deadlines.
- 7. If applying to BC universities/colleges go to <a href="www.applybc.ca">www.applybc.ca</a> and set up your account or apply directly to the institution via the website.
- 8. If applying to Ontario universities go to <a href="www.ouca.ca">www.ouca.ca</a> and set up your account.
- 9. If applying to universities in other parts of Canada go to the individual university websites.
- 10. Before applying to the university have a first and second choice of faculties (eg. 1<sup>st</sup> choice Science; 2<sup>nd</sup> choice Arts).
- 11. All you need to fill out the application form is your choice of faculties and a credit card.

  Remember you can save an incomplete application and return to it later.
- 12. Once you have applied you will start to receive emails. MAKE SURE YOU READ THE EMAILS AND FOLLOW DIRECTIONS.
- 13. Do not ask for an interim transcript until the universities/colleges ask you to send one in.
- 14. Make sure you have completed your PSI Selections Form so your marks can be automatically sent to the BC universities/colleges you apply to. (Link is on the EMS website under Counselling Department).
- 15. If you are asked to self-report grades be accurate, do not inflate your grades. Remember to have evidence to support your marks (eg. report card, marks print out).
