Dear Sunrise Ridge Families,

As we move towards Winter Break, please remain vigilant and monitor your child's health for any signs of COVID-19 (new or worsening signs) including cough, fever, muscle aches, fatigue, sore throat, nausea/vomiting, headache, loss of appetite, chills, runny nose or nasal congestion, loss of sense of smell or taste, diarrhea. **Keep your child home if they are not well.**

At school we will continue to maintain vigilance with cleaning protocols, hand washing, wearing masks and physically distancing by cohort groups, inside the school. **If you wish for your child to wear a mask at school, please ensure that your child is aware of this request and have a clean mask each day when they come to school.**

**Also, we are highly recommending when parents are on school property that they remain 2 metres apart and where a mask to keep all our community safe.**

## **Communicating Student Learning WEEK (CSL) from November 30- Dec 4th**

Teachers communicate learning in various ways: conferences, phone calls, sending work home, class newsletters, planners, Fresh Grade and more. All classes are using Fresh Grade as both a communication and reporting tool this year. Fresh Grade is not intended to document everything your child does in school, but should provide evidence of learning in all subject areas at different times throughout the year. Teachers will typically use comments/feedback and/or a proficiency level when evidence of student learning is added. Students will also comment on their own learning in relation to the learning standards as well. The language in the proficiency scale has changed slightly this year so the focus is on the understanding. It's also the same scale used on all provincial assessments.

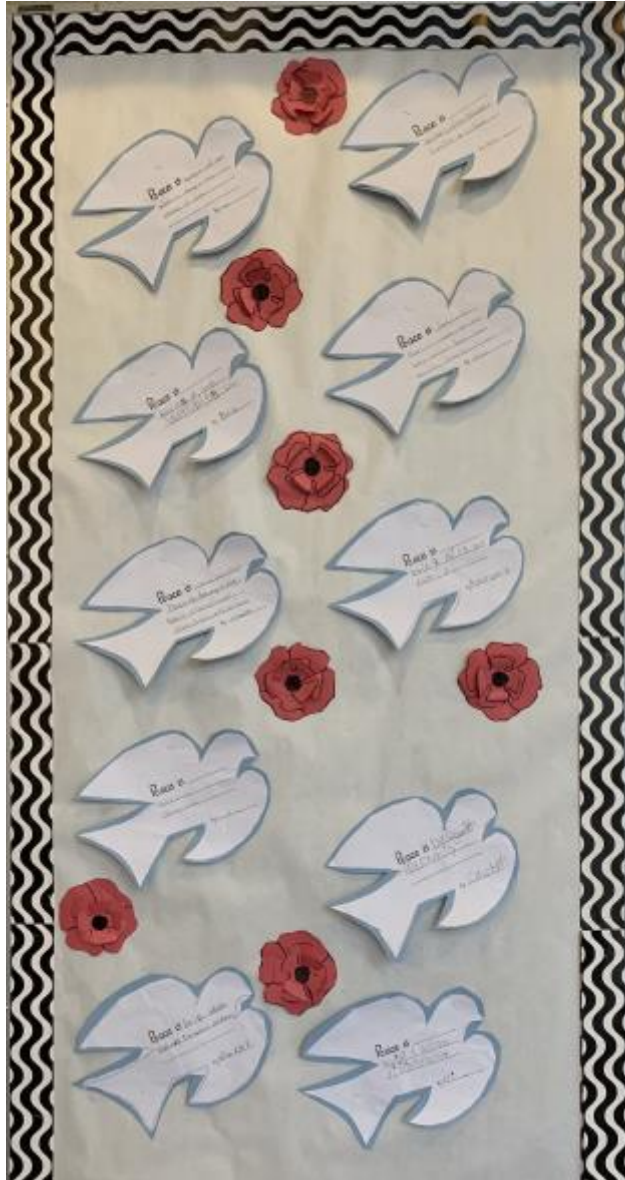
















## Sunrise Ridge Remembers

## Kindergarten Registration January 2021

**It is time to register for**

# KINDERGARTEN

Children who will turn five years old before January 1, 2022 are eligible to begin school in September 2021

Registration begins in Surrey schools **Monday, January 11, 2021**

**To REGISTER, PLEASE CONTACT YOUR LOCAL SCHOOL**

**The SURREY SCHOOL DISTRICT IS NOW USING A WEB-BASED ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM**  
 Once submitted, the form and any supporting documents will be available to school staff and the Principal who will use their judgement to determine if documentation requirements have been satisfied. The following documents are required to complete the registration process and may be uploaded to the registration portal or presented in person at the catchment school or school-of-choice:

1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport)
2. Proof of guardianship (as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant assessment or guardianship order)
3. Proof of Citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card, Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card)
4. Proof of residence (e.g., -rental agreement) of parent/guardian in BC:
  - a. Three pieces of identification showing the address of residence (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
  - b. One of the three pieces above must be government issued in order to complete the registration process (BC driver's license, BC Services Card, BCID or BC Care Card of parent/legal guardian).

**Documents which are helpful, but not required:**

- Health Documents (Care card, immunization records, medical condition information)

 Application to these programs is made through the online lottery system starting Monday, January 25, 2021.
