

1. First try to remember - what the book/s looked like:

- How big was it?
- Was it thick or thin?
- Was it hardcover or paperback?
- What did the cover look like?
- **Remember Surrey Schools library books have barcodes - SURREY SD# 36.**

2. Ask yourself when you last had the book and the look everywhere...

- In the Car (check under the seats and in the trunk)
- Under the baby's car seat
- In the other car
- In your backpack
- In your folder or binder
- In your sibling's backpack or binder
- At Grandma's house
- At your friend's house
- On top of a shelf, piano, refrigerator
- Under or in back of sofa (check under cushions)
- Under or on top of the kitchen or dining room table
- On your bedroom bookshelf
- On one of the other bookshelves
(Check all the books turned around backwards and behind other books on the bookshelf)
- On/in your brother/sister's desk
- Under your bed
- Under your brother/sister's bed
- Between your bed and the wall
- In or on top of the dresser
- In the closet (check all closets)
- Under the dirty clothes pile
- In the toy box
- In the bathroom
- On the back porch or in the back yard
- In the play house
- Under or on top of the TV or stereo
- In the magazine rack

- Under the rug
 - Ask your parents if they've seen it
 - Ask your brother/ sister if they've seen it
 - Ask other relatives if they've seen it
 - At the local public library (if you returned it there, it will come back to Surrey Schools eventually)
 - At your daycare/after-school care facility
 - In the vehicle of whoever you ride to school with
 - On the classroom or teacher's bookshelf
 - In your neighbor's or friend's desk (*ask their permission before looking*)
 - In the cafeteria, gym, art room, etc.
- 3. Last but not least, think about the last time your parents told you to clean your room.**
- Now, think about the various places you shoved piles of things, so that they would think you'd actually cleaned it.
 - Make sure you check all of those places, too.
