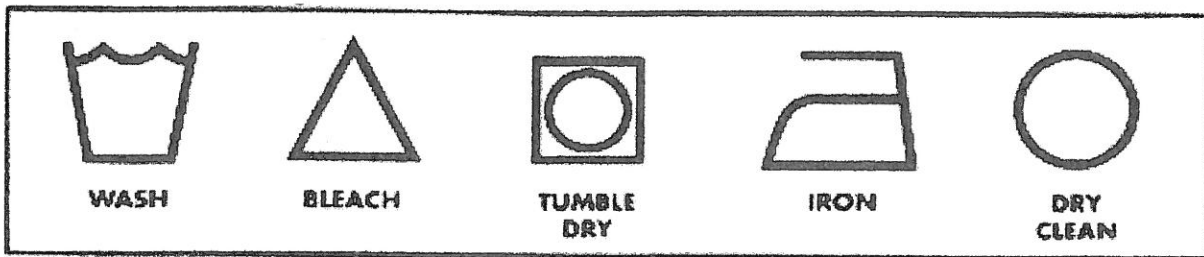
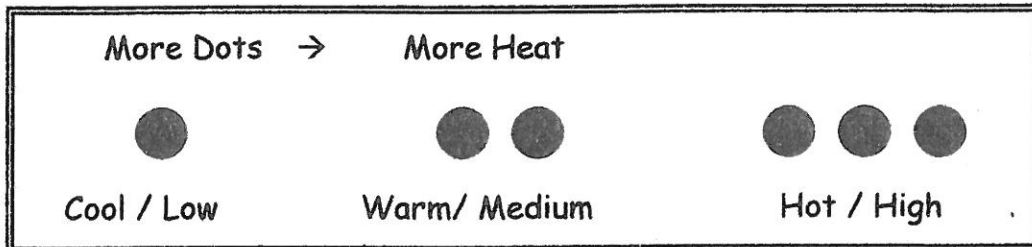

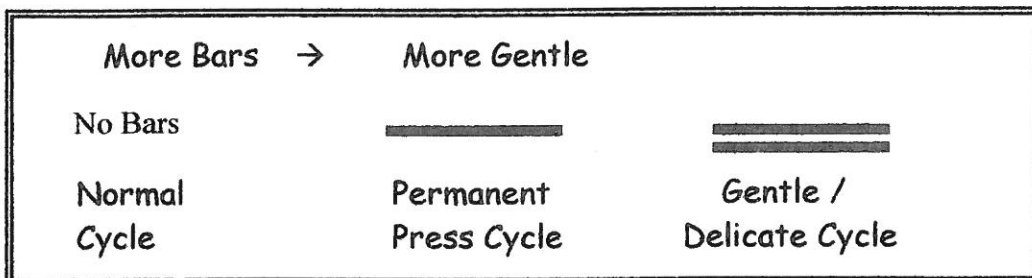
Taking good care of your clothes and washing them according to garment care instructions will help them look newer and last longer. There are five basic symbols required to appear on all garments to help consumers like us identify the proper care treatments. These symbols appear in black and white and are the same for garments made throughout North America and overseas. The five symbols are:



The temperature treatment appears in degrees Celsius or is defined by a series of dots.



Bars help to illustrate the severity of the treatment during washing and drying.



An "X" through any symbol means DO NOT do this!
