Principals and Vice Principals Message

- The time commitment required from parents will depend on a number of factors including the grade level of the student and the approach
 used by the school and individual teacher.
- Please do not enter your school building unless you have authorization from your principal.

Communication

There are a few action items below that require all students to complete and have parents ensure this has been completed for their child.

1. All classroom teachers made contact with their students last week. If you child was NOT contacted by a teacher, please email <u>kupfer m@surreyschools.ca</u>

2. If you have new contact information (address, phone or email), please email <u>kupfer m@surreyschools.ca</u>

3. If your family receives call with a "blocked number", the caller may be a teacher. If your phone has a feature to block unknown numbers you may want to turn this feature off.

4. Office hours for teachers will be similar to the school day. Some teachers may contact families with suggested online check-in times. If you or your child has any questions for their classroom teacher outside of established office hours, please email or send a message through TEAMS.

5. Some classes may be using Microsoft TEAMS to communicate. Please see the instructions below for accessing TEAMS.



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How to Access Microsoft TEAMS at Home:

- 1) Visit tescott.ca/o in a web browser.
- Log in with your child's surrey schools username and password. Email tescott@surreyschools.ca if you do not know their username or password.
- 3) Click on the teams app.
- 4) Click on the team for your child's class.
- 5) You can also download the app for teams on your laptop or phone.
