Take Our Kids to Work! is organized by The Learning Partnership, a national charitable organization dedicated to bringing together business, education, government, labour, policy makers and the community to support a strong public education system in Canada.

The more students understand about the jobs of their parents and relatives, the more informed the decisions about their own future career will be.

This event provides Grade 9 students with the opportunity to have a one-day, real-life experience in a work environment.

Benefits to students:

- ▶ Develop an appreciation for the importance of staying in school and getting a high school diploma and pursuing post-secondary studies.
- ▶ Gain exposure to the skills required in today's workplaces.
- ▶ Develop an appreciation for their parents' roles in making a living and supporting their families.
- ▶ Begin career discussions with adults about the work they do.
- ▶ Gain a better understanding of the complexity of career choices and the benefits of early exploration.
- ▶ Explore career options in practical ways.
