# Community Safety Workshop Series

Surrey Schools is launching a new series of workshops focused on creating safe and caring spaces for youth. Following input from last month's community consultation, the district worked with community partners to design workshops that address many of the questions brought forward by the community in December. The sessions are intended to assist students and their families in accessing available resources to support their safety and well-being and establish the appropriate community connections.

The January 18th session will cover:

- Programs and supports offered by the Surrey School District and the City of Surrey
- Community resources and how to access them
- Information for supporting safe schools and communities
- Strategies for having open dialogue with youth and bridging generational gaps

Parents and community members are encouraged to attend, ask questions and share ideas for future workshops. The session is free and will be offered in English and Punjabi.
