SFU Indigenous University Preparation Program is still accepting applications! The Indigenous University Preparation Program (IUPP) at Simon Fraser University is now accepting student applications for their next cohort, beginning in Fall 2021 (early application deadline April 30, 2021). The program helps pave the way for Indigenous Students to successfully transition to undergraduate studies using small cohort-style classes and a supportive atmosphere. They offer first-year academic credit courses that integrate humanities and social sciences with Indigenous perspectives. Although a fairly young program, they have had the opportunity to open the door to a university education for our students through their unique approach to build foundations in math and writing as well.
