YMCA Youth Employment Program - Recruitment Now Open

The YMCA's Youth Breakthrough to Employment and Training (YBEAT) program is gearing up for its next intake!

YBEAT is a free 5-week program that supports youth ages 17-29 who experience mental health barriers, stress, or anxiety around returning to the workforce. The program includes workshops on pre-employment skills, mental wellness, as well as 1-1 support from an Employment Coach. Upon completion of the 5-week program, participants must engage in 12-weeks of part-time, full-time or volunteer work to further develop their skills and gain experience.

The next intake starts November 8 and it will be delivered online through Zoom. Recruitment for this program is now open, and there are 15 spots to fill. If you are working with a youth that matches the eligibility criteria below, please fill out the inquiry form and an employment coach will be in touch with the youth within 24 hours. Alternatively, you can direct them to our information session at ymcayouthbeat.eventbrite.ca

Basic eligibility criteria:

- Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, or Confirmed Refugees
- Between 17 and 29 years old
- Unemployed or precariously employed (<20 hours per week)
- Experiencing stress, anxiety, depression, or mental health barriers to employment
- Not currently in school or taking 1-2 courses only
