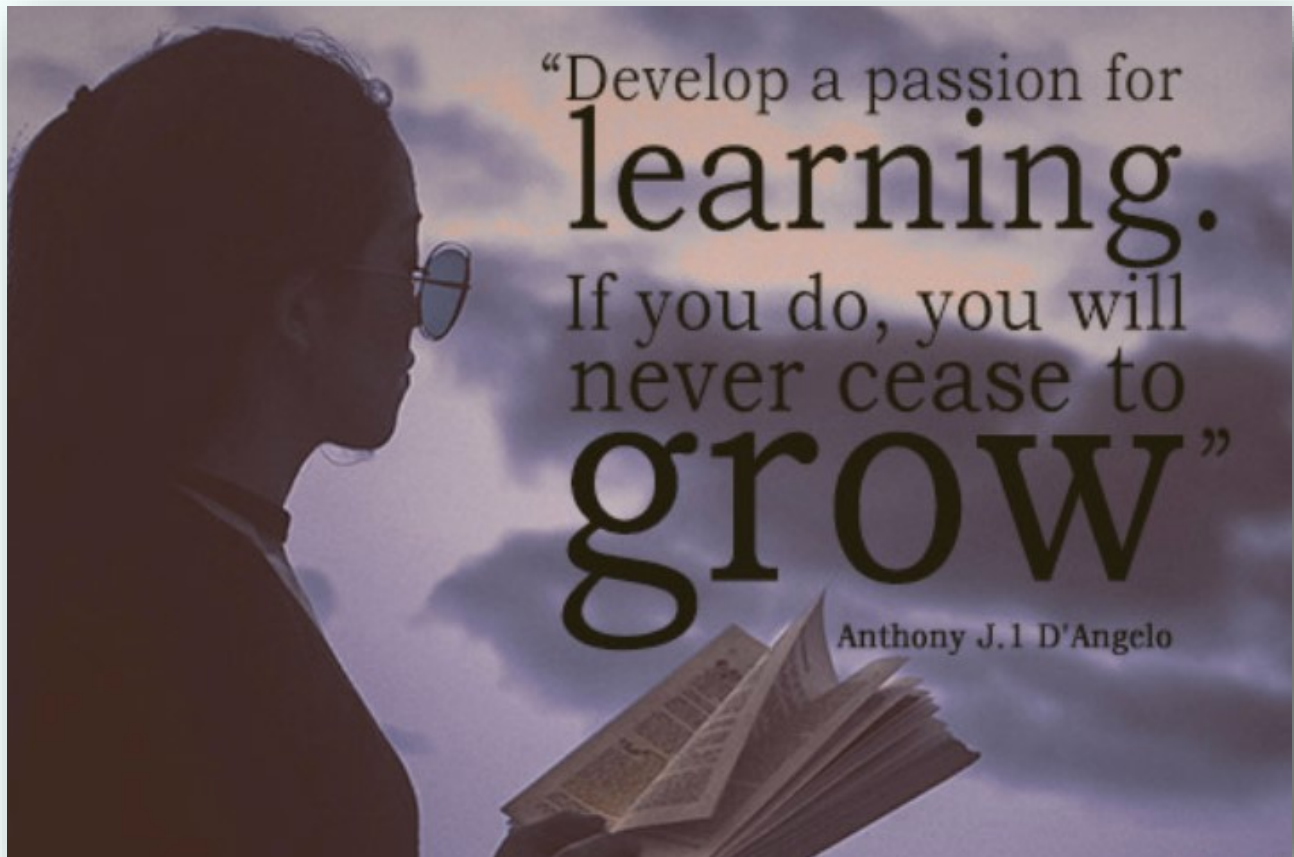

PHE students also took advantage of the sunshine for a fast paced game of Ultimate!



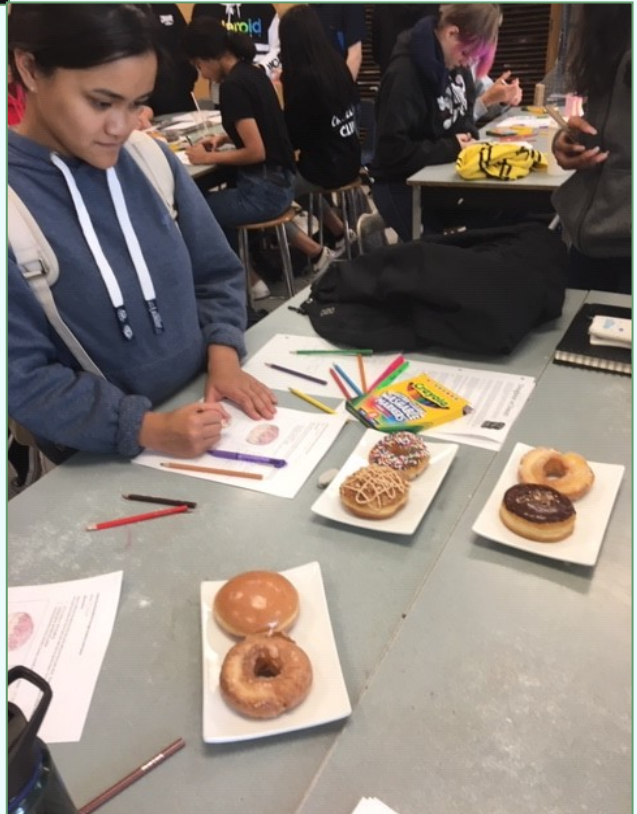
