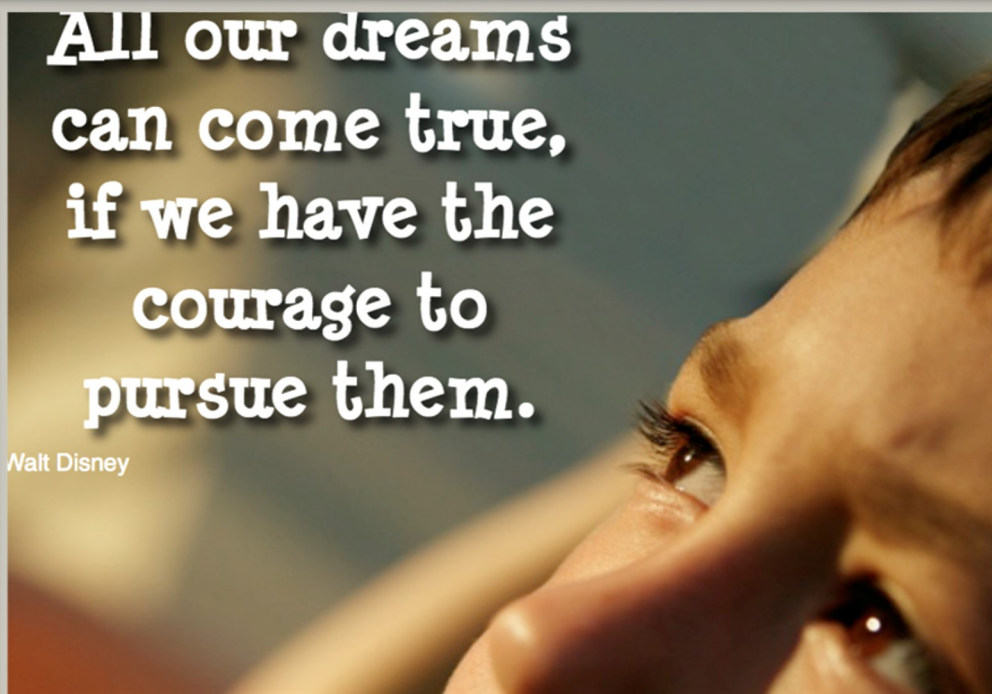

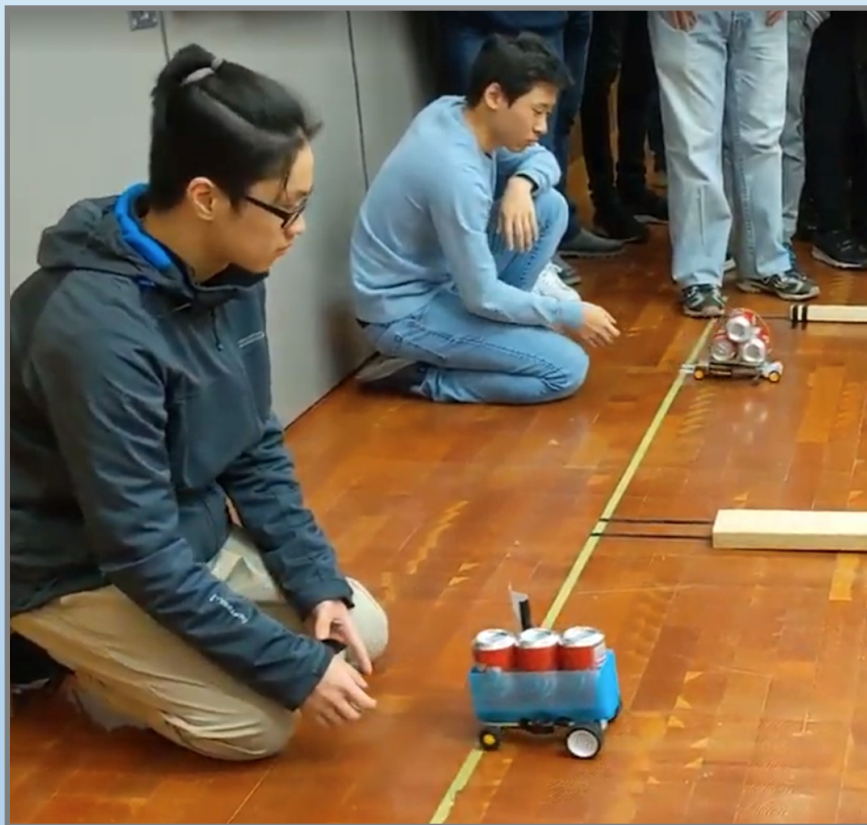




### **"This Week at Fleetwood Park" - Principal's Message: December 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>**
